Since *Legal Requirements & Program Regulations of the Federal Depository Library Program* was published in June 2011, the Government Publishing Office has continued to update and enhance resources and policies in support of your Federal depository operations and the patrons your libraries serve. As a result, some information within the document merits updating.

This update to Legal Requirements & Program Regulations of the Federal Depository Library Program documents five changes within Part 111, the FDLP Regulations.

Three changes do not constitute substantive changes to the regulations themselves, but document a change in the resource referenced within the regulations.

- 4. FDLP-L has been replaced by the FDLP News and Events announcement service.
- 25. & 38. The new FDLP Decal, replacing what is in the document, is described.

Changes to the two other regulations are more substantive.

- 10. This regulation was removed to allow for the development of all digital depositories.
- 57. Additional withdrawal options now available for regional depository libraries per the Regional Discard Policy are accounted for.
