How to Participate

Registry of U.S. Government Publication Digitization Projects

Let GPO know what your institution is working on by including your digitization projects in the Registry of U.S. Government Publication Digitization Projects (<http://registry.fdlp.gov/>). You can also search the Registry to find out what other libraries are digitizing and to find possible partners for a collaborative project and avoid duplication of effort.

Become a Digitization Partner
