







Library Planning & Development

- Manages Web site content, design, and maintenance






Library Planning & Development

- Planning for electronic collections and authentication services, managing GPO's partnerships, planning for migration of legacy systems, & creating process and workflow documentation






- Special projects support throughout LSCM, including formal Project Management leadership role






Web Content Management



- · Special projects that support overall LSCM organization












LPD Accomplishments

- Concept of Operations (ConOps) and Requirements Document (RD) completed for LIST systems migration
- ConOps drafted for Needs & Offers Tool, posted for community feedback.
- Enhanced WebTech Notes Launched on FDLP Desktop.
- Partnership Updates
 - New Partnership with Cornell University Law Library "one year pilot project to evaluate conversion of CFR into XML".
 - · Renewed Partnerships with Southern Methodist University & Library of Michigan.
 - Full implementation in January of the partnership with the Association of Schools of Public Health (ASPH) for electronic access to Public Health Reports





LPD Path Forward

- Collaboratively develop the RD for Needs & Offers Tool
- Technology mapping for LIST RD and N&O RD
- FDLP Community Site
 - For the FDLP Community site, WCM has been working closely with various library groups such as Council, Regional's (Ann Sanders), the Gov Doc Kids Group, and GODORT Ohio who have reached out to us to support migrating from their existing sites to the FDLP Community.
