

PRESIDENTIAL RADIO ADDRESS SATURDAY, APRIL 22, 1995

PRESIDENT CLINTON: We are especially concerned about how the children of America are reacting to the temble currents in Oklahoma City

Our family has been strugging to make sense of this tragedy. And I know that families all over America have as well. We have that what happened in Oldshorms is very frightening.
