


# U.S. Congressional Serial Set govinfo Collection



## What is the U.S. Congressional Serial Set?

- Numbered House and Senate documents and reports bound by session of Congress.
- Began with the 1st session of the 15th Congress (1817).
- Volumes include committee reports, treaty materials, presidential communications to Congress, and some executive agency materials and non-governmental publications.



## Navigating the Collection

- Browse by Congress and then Serial Set Number
- Search by Keyword or President
- Search by Citation (*H. Misc. Doc. 38-78*)
- Advanced Search – Full-text river exploration, subject geographic Colorado
- Search results filters – Refine any search using the **govinfo** filters.
- Content Details – Lots of metadata is available on the content details page.
- Find the other documents in the Serial Set volume using Document in Context.

## Collection Background


- Since June 2019, GPO and the Law Library of Congress have been working together to provide public access to the U.S. Congressional Serial Set.
- Under the partnership, the Law Library is digitizing Serial Set volumes and performing quality control on the digitization. The majority of the volumes being digitized are also from the Law Library's collection.
- GPO is generating metadata, digitally signing the PDF files, and providing access on **govinfo**. Additionally, we are acquiring replacement volumes when requested by the Law Library.
- When completed, the **govinfo** collection will contain Serial Set volumes 1-14,277 (from the 15th Congress through the 103rd Congress).
- Initial public release was September 28, 2021 and included a selection of Serial Set volumes from the 69th Congress, the 82nd Congress, and several 19th century Congresses.


