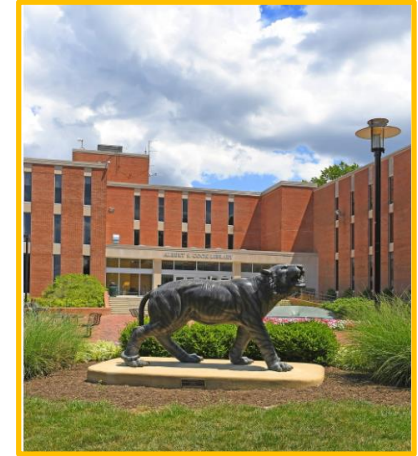

Access to Federal Documents

- ❑ 1863: Towson University founded as Maryland Normal School;
- ❑ 1979: Joined the FDLP; 5-6% Selective Depository;
- ❑ 1999: Left the FDLP due to renovation; completed de-accession in 2004;
- ❑ 2005-2010: Maintained a document liaison;
- ❑ UMCP Regional Depository began a monthly document load;
- ❑ September 11, 2011: Cook Library rejoined as an all-electronic depository;
- ❑ College Park included TU in monthly load;



- ❑ 72,715 PURL Records linked the day we rejoined;
- ❑ 2016: Migrated from in-house to LibGuides;
- ❑ 2020: Pandemic lockdown. Full reactivation, post-pandemic: July 7, 2021;
- ❑ 2021: Tenth Depository Anniversary: 169,986 PURL Records now available.
- ❑ 20,675 non-depository electronic books purchased;
- ❑ (not including PDA and eBook aggregators.)

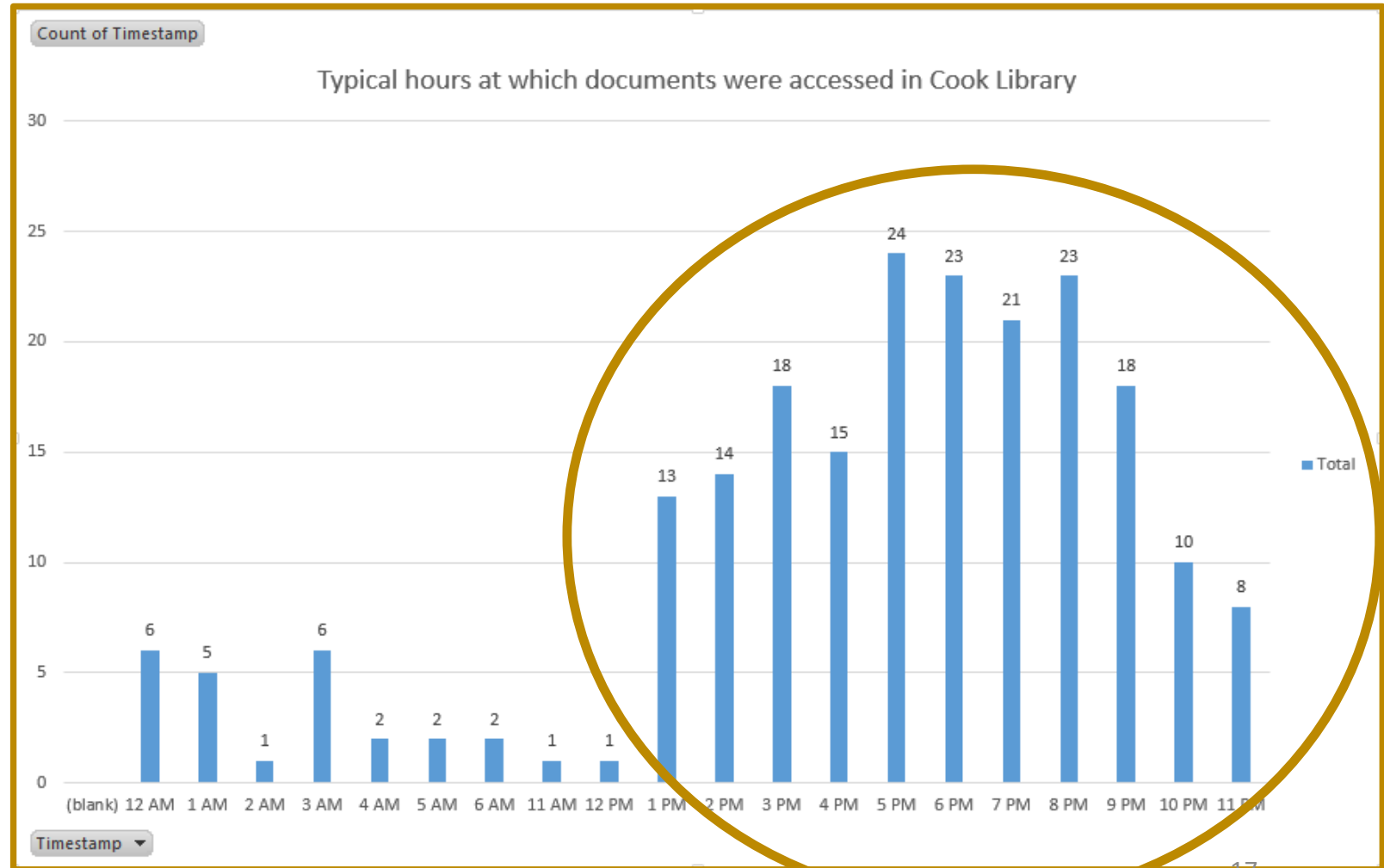
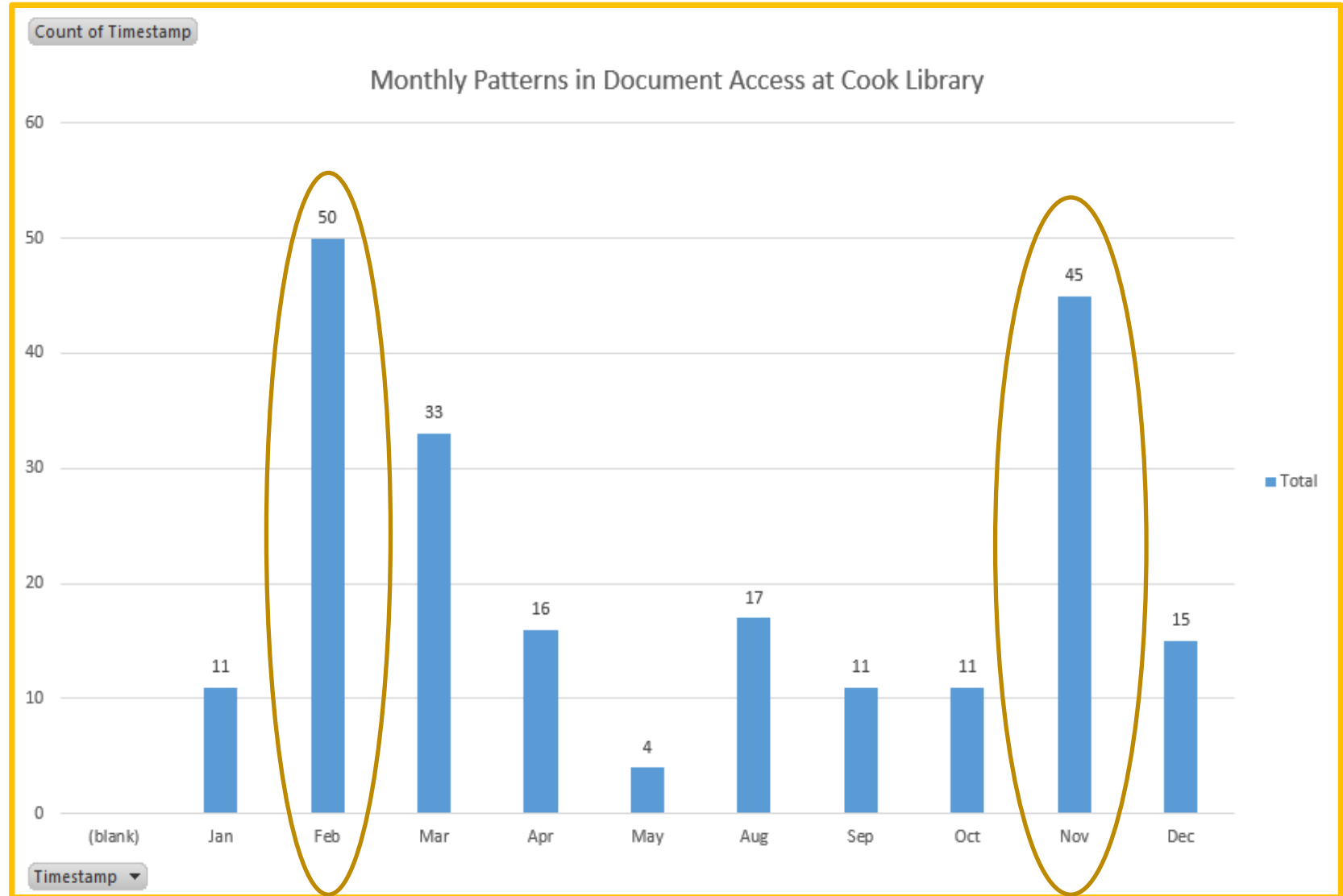


Table 2: Monthly Patterns

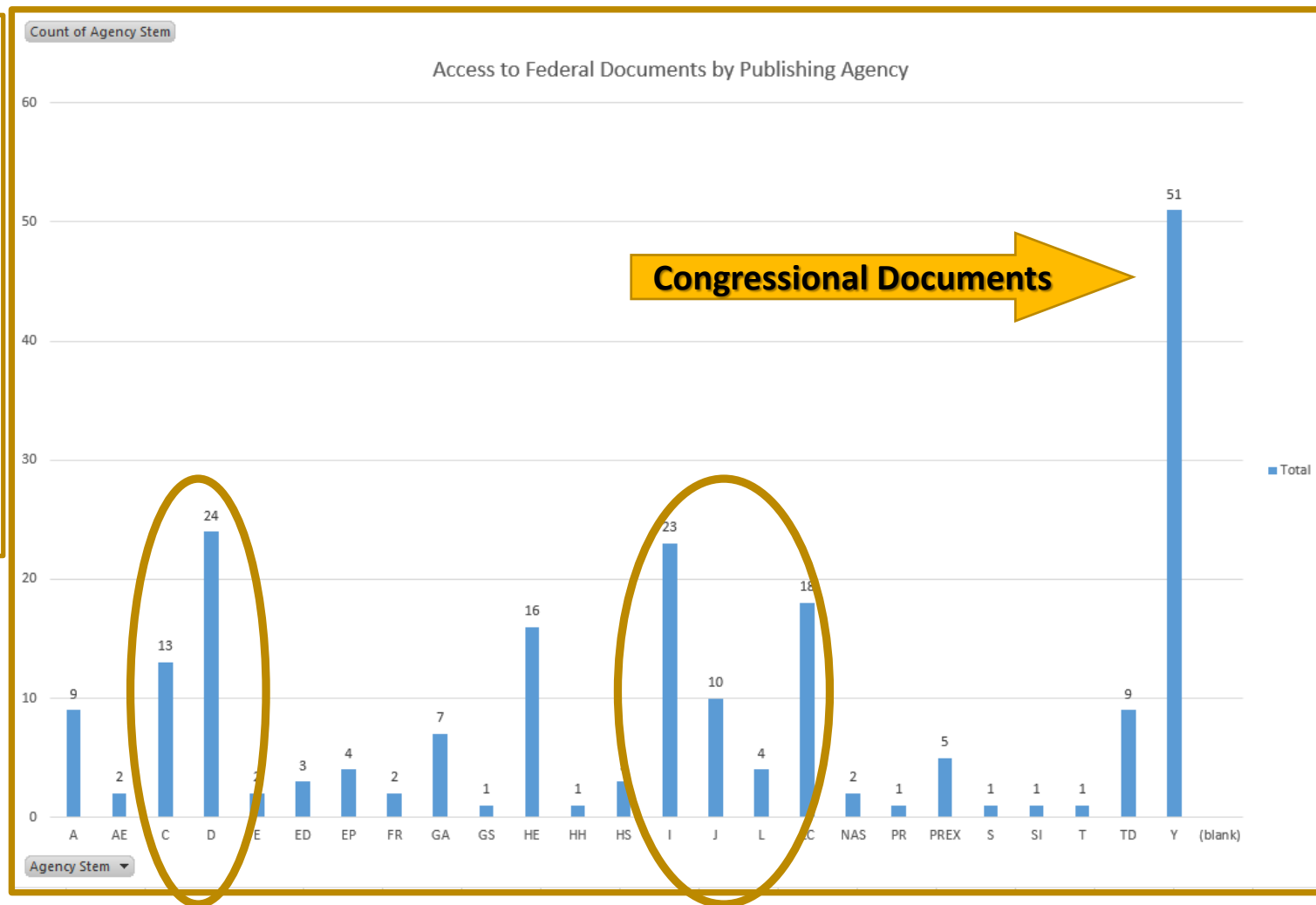
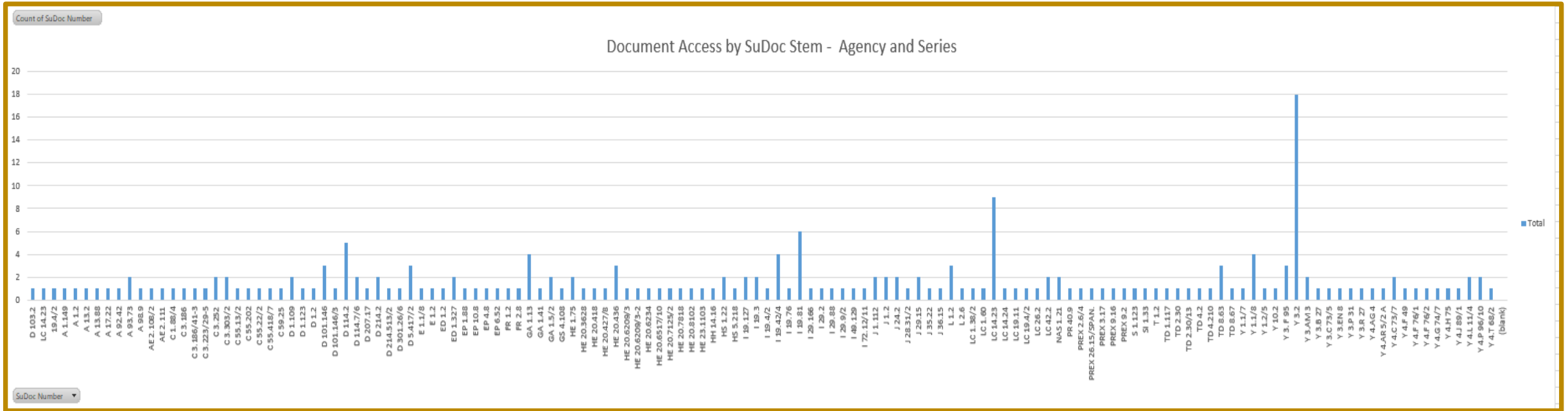


Table 4: SuDoc Agency/Stem

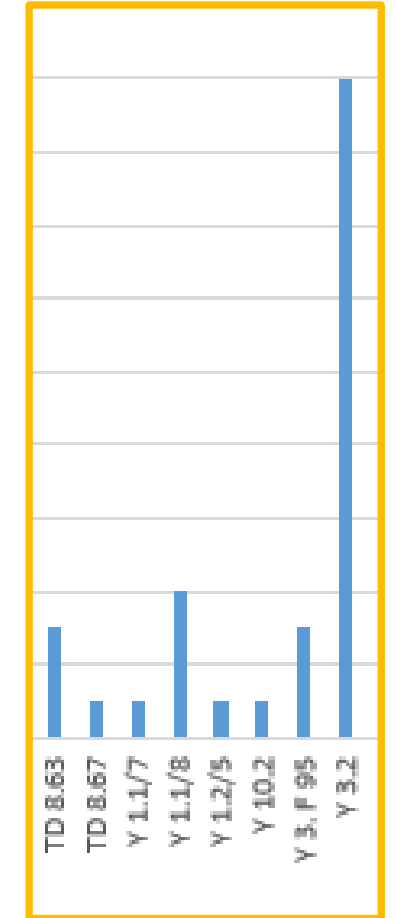
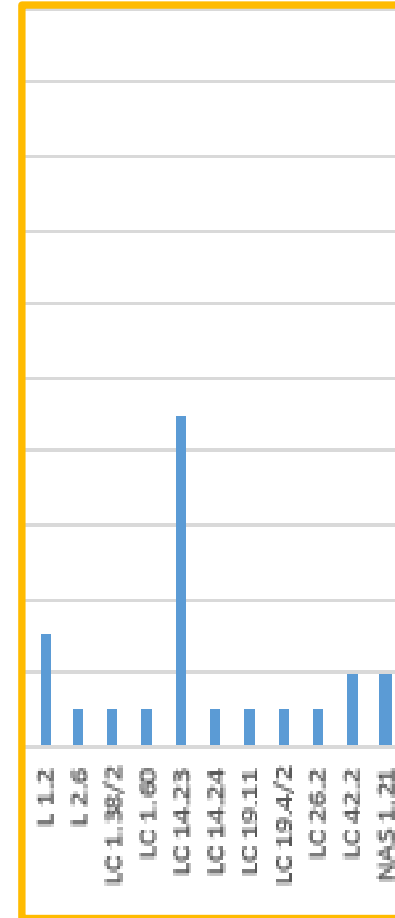
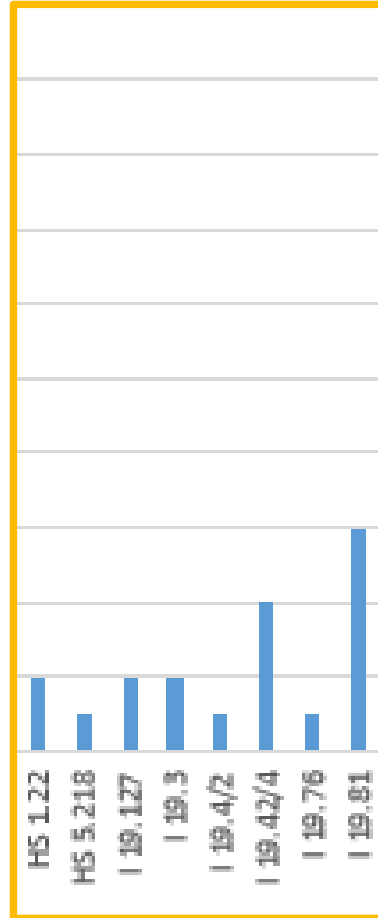

Conclusions

- ❑ Use correlates to research topics and library instruction;
- ❑ Specialized documents will need either weeding or promotion;

- ❑ New Topic Guides for use in courses;
- ❑ Seek to include documents in teaching;
- ❑ Search holdings in most and least agency series;
- ❑ Placement of federal resources in Course Guides;
- ❑ New Information Literacy Course (tent., Fall 2022);
- ❑ New video tutorials on documents by subject area;
- ❑ Avail of GPO resources and personal contacts;
