About the Congressional Serial Set

HELP

The United States Congressional Serial Set collection was digitized by the Law Library of Congress, and is made publicly available through a partnership between the U.S. Government Publishing Office and the Law Library of Congress. The joint digitization project is a multi-year effort. Additional volumes of the Serial Set will be added to this collection as they are available.

The Serial Set is comprised of the numbered Senate and House Documents and Senate and House Reports, bound by Session of Congress. The contents of the Serial Set have varied throughout the publication's history, and at times have included House and Senate Journals, and the reports of executive departments and agencies.

Each volume is assigned a Serial Number, beginning with the 1st Session of the 15th Congress in 1817. Reports and Documents for each chamber begin with Number 1 at the beginning of the Congress, and are numbered consecutively through all sessions of that Congress. [Read More](#)

The U.S. Government Publishing Office (GPO) takes another step in its publishing and manufacturing modernization efforts by using XPub, GPO's digital system for XML-based publishing, to produce the Select Committee on the Modernization of Congress final report and recommendations. GPO produced this report under a tight deadline using a modern, user-friendly layout that includes color, graphics, images, and modern fonts. This report is an example of the capabilities and features GPO's XPub will be able to offer Congressional committees and Federal agencies. The report will be printed on GPO's new digital inkjet presses, which are enhancing the agency's flexibility to meet its customers' needs for both large and small print jobs.

Statute Compilations in USLM XML Format

News This project is the latest effort in the overall legislative branch strategy to move more legislative publications into USLM XML

The U.S. Government Publishing Office (GPO) and its legislative data partners in the U.S. House of Representatives and the U.S. Senate have made Statute Compilations available in USLM XML format. This new format makes documents easier to use, read, and download.

Access Statute Compilations in USLM XML format via [Search](#), [Browse](#), [Bulk Data](#), and the **govinfo** [API](#).

Statute Compilations are compilations of public laws that either do not appear in the U.S. Code or that have been classified to a title of the U.S. Code that has not been enacted into positive law. Each Statute Compilation incorporates the amendments made to the underlying statute since it was originally enacted. This collection encompasses select non-positive law statutes. Over 2,100 Statute Compilations are now currently available on **govinfo**.

Metrics

- 9.4M PDF files and 21.3M image files in the **govinfo** preservation repository.
- PDF, Text, and XML are the predominant file formats.
- 320K packages added to **govinfo** in FY21.
- 5 minute average processing time from ingest to availability on the public website.
- 70M average monthly public website file retrievals in FY21.
- 837M public website file retrievals in FY21.
- 4.8B public website file retrievals since January 2009.
