

What is the difference between Preservation Stewards and Print Selectors?

	Preservation Stewards	Print Selectors
Retention commitment	Preservation Stewards commit to retaining, and preserving, tangible depository resources for the duration of their agreement.	Print Selectors select and retain the print format for a specified period of time, after which they have the option to discard.
Inventory requirement	Preservation Stewards submit an inventory of the tangible depository resources they intend to retain and preserve. Preservation Stewards are not obligated to fill gaps or add current receipts to their inventories, but may submit updated inventories at any time.	Print Selectors are not required to submit an inventory of current receipts.
Catalog of U.S. Government Publications (CGP) holdings	Preservation Steward commitments are reflected in CGP item holdings.	Print Selectors are not reflected in CGP item holdings.
Who can participate?	Both selectives and regionals can be Preservation Stewards.	Both selectives and regionals can be Print Selectors.
