THE UNITED STATES,

FEBRUARY 2, 1819.

The committee, to whom was referred the petition of Pierre Lacoste,. REPORT:

That the losses for which the petitioner prays indemnity, were losses occasioned by the destruction of the British, at the time of their invasion of Louisiana. It does not appear from the evidence, that the British caused the destruction in consequence of any use which the United States' troops had made of the buildings, or of the plantation; but that the injuries sustained, had been committed subsequently to the time when the houses had been used, and the plantation occupied by the United States' troops and stores.

The committee, therefore, recommend that the petitioner have leave to withdraw his petition.

FDLP.gov Modernization

- **Discovery**. This process examined and compared the requirements in the contract with the current website. This allowed the team to clarify requirements to the contractor and refine them as needed.
- Servers. A development instance of the new FDLP.gov was implemented and is being used to create the new functionality and perform testing.
- **Sprints**. The team is working through and testing sprints. Each sprint represents a build of certain requirements and functionality. GPO then performs User Acceptance Testing (UAT) of the work that was accomplished in the sprint.
- Next step: open the development site to internal testing.
