

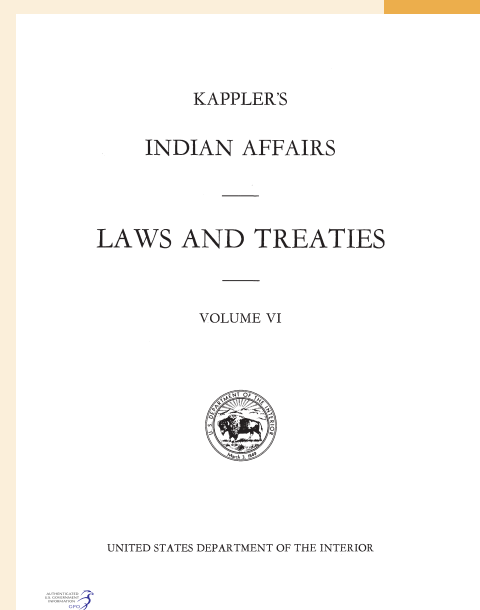

Digitization

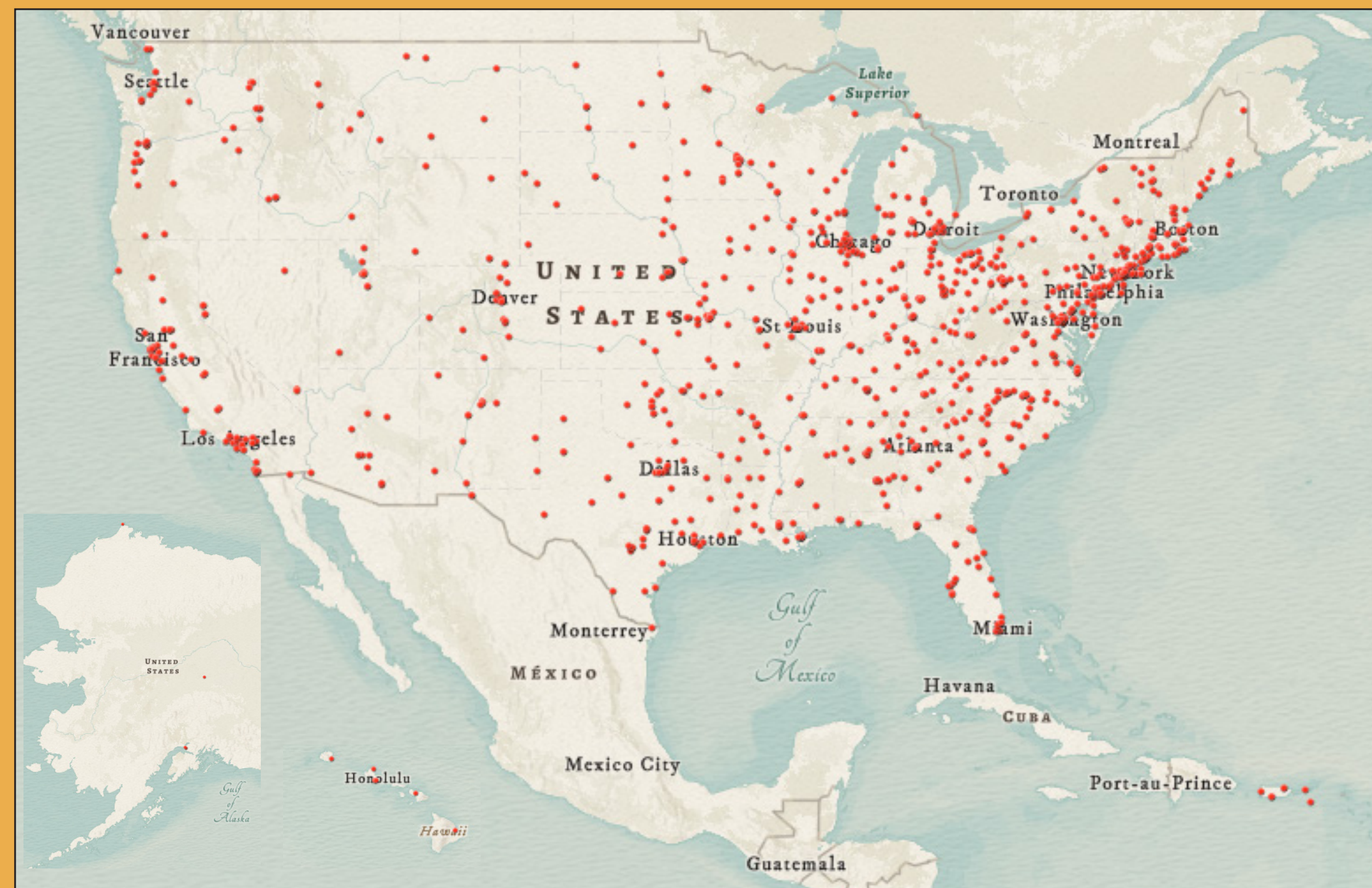
- [govinfo](#) is a critical digital component of the *National Collection*
