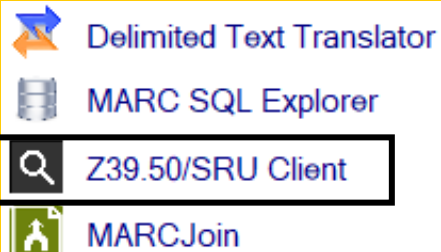
Configure OCLC Worldcat to

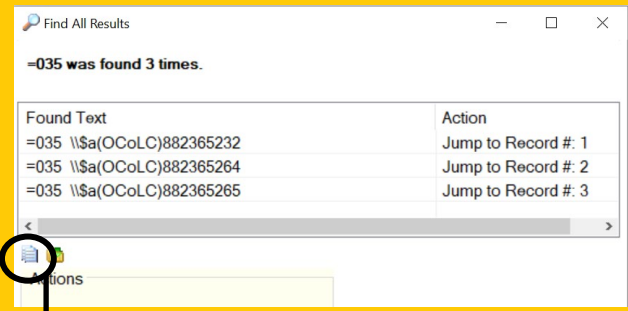

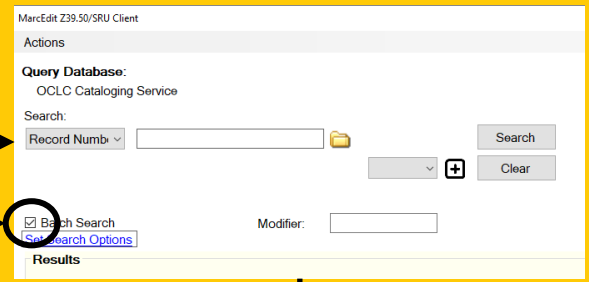
