- State Forecasts will be used to identify the current and future depository library environment.
- The forecast will be used to gather information about the following general areas:
 - Depository institutions and library types
 - Economics
 - Demographics of service area
 - Technology
 - Current library environment (e.g., consortia, non-depository libraries, etc.)
 - Other information to be determined
- Steps to create a 5-year State Forecast
 - Step 1: Complete a template for your individual library
 - Step 2: Meet to discuss and compile individual libraries' templates into one final State Forecast.
- State Forecast information will be used to develop a State Focused Action Plan.

Example of Forecast elements:

Economics

- Parent library budget – ↓ Decreasing 10%
- Possible anticipated impact
 - Separate reference desks are combined into one unified service desk

Demographics

- Changes in communities served
 - Population – ↓ Decreasing **10%**
 - **(Many** other changes.)
- Possible anticipated impacts
 - Need to reassess collection focus to meet needs and interests of new community demographic.
 - Increased need to target information for the new community demographic
 - Need to increase information collection and advertisement of federal materials available electronically to users through the Federal Depository Library.

Important Dates:

- Complete templates for the Forecast and Action Plans are being finalized and will be pilot tested before release which is anticipated in December/January. Information will be made available on the FDLP Desktop.
- State Forecasts and State Focused Action Plans are due to GPO by June 30, 2012.
