<p>Collected and organized data from the 2021 Biennial Survey, specifically from Question 6[1]: “In which areas, if any, has your institution implemented new policies and/or procedural changes as a result of COVID-19?”</p>	<p>Begin examination of remaining Biennial Survey data, “Question 6[2],” which includes qualitative responses on whether FDLs plan to keep their COVID-19 policies in place into the future.</p>
<p>Examined majority of collected data to assess the immediate impact of COVID-19 upon the FDL community.</p>	<p>Draft an official report of findings for Spring 2023 Depository Library Council Virtual Meeting.</p>
<p>Added new DLC members to the working group and elected new secretary.</p>	
<p>Worked with GPO staff to test Teams as a potential communications platform.</p>
