

2011 RESULT HIGHLIGHTS

THE PURPOSE OF THE BIENNIAL SURVEY IS TO REPORT ON THE CONDITIONS IN DEPOSITORY LIBRARIES. REQUIRED BY LAW (44 USC §1909), THE BIENNIAL SURVEY GATHERS DATA FROM ALL OF THE DEPOSITORY LIBRARIES EVERY 2 YEARS.


- * SENT TO 1,201 DEPOSITORY LIBRARIES PARTICIPATING IN THE FEDERAL DEPOSITORY LIBRARY PROGRAM (FDLP) AS OF 9.2011.
- * SELECT RESULTS APPEAR IN THIS INFOGRAPHIC. A FULL RESULTS REPORT IS AVAILABLE FOR DOWNLOAD AT FDLP.GOV.
- * SUBMISSIONS RECEIVED FROM 1,181 DEPOSITORY LIBRARIES = 98% RESPONSE RATE FROM FDLP PARTICIPANTS.
- * ALL DEPOSITORIES WERE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT RESPONSES.

OF LIBRARIES HAVE OFFICIAL HOUSING AGREEMENTS (SHAS).

92% OF LIBRARIES HAVE ALL TITLES IN THE FDLP BASIC COLLECTION, IN AT LEAST ONE FORMAT, ACCESSIBLE FOR IMMEDIATE USE BY THEIR USERS.



97% OF LIBRARIES ALLOW ANY MEMBER OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC (REGARDLESS OF RESIDENCY IN THE LIBRARY SERVICE AREA, AGE, DISABILITY, OR OTHER STATUS) ACCESS & USE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT INFORMATION RESOURCES IN ALL FORMATS & RECEIVE REFERENCE SERVICES FREE OF CHARGE AT THEIR LIBRARY & SELECTIVE HOUSING SITES.






DOES YOUR LIBRARY PLAN TO REMAIN

DESCRIBE YOUR DEPOSITORY COLLECTION CHARACTERISTICS






