Recommendation 1: PID Principles

The Exploring the Durability of PURLs and Their Alternatives Working Group of the Depository Library Council recommends the Council endorse these Principles for PIDs and PID systems, and further recommends they be transmitted to the Director of GPO with a recommendation that they be adopted.

Recommendation 2: Training on PURLs

The Exploring the Durability of PURLs and Their Alternatives Working Group proposes that the Depository Library Council recommend to GPO that training be offered on PURLs that includes, but is not limited to, referral reports, how to create a library's report profile, how the data can be used to promote Government resources, and features in GPO bibliographic records that relate to PURLs.

Activities, 2022 - 2023

- Examined and organized qualitative and quantitative data from 2021 Biennial Survey question 6, which related to the impact of COVID-19 on FDL operations between 2020 and 2021.
- Continued testing Teams as a potential communications and file sharing platform for GPO.
- Created written summaries to highlight and examine qualitative responses from the FDL community.
- Created a machine readable datafile and shareable R code so members of the FDL community can explore the quantitative data themselves.
- Currently drafting a white paper for GPO and DLC that will include a thorough summary of the study, suggestions for future Biennial Survey questions, and recommendations for future studies on this topic.

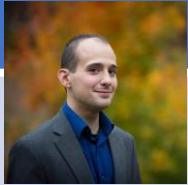

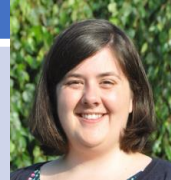

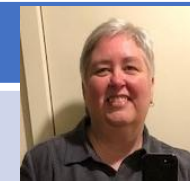
