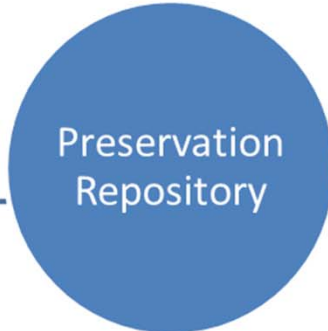


Next Generation FDsys (NextGen)

Securely controls digital content throughout its lifecycle to ensure authenticity and integrity.



Follows archival system standards to ensure long-term preservation and access of digital content.



Combines extensive metadata with modern search technology.

Background

- GPO's Federal Digital System (FDsys) was publicly launched on January 15, 2009, after the initial design, development, and usability testing were completed in the summer of 2008.
- FDsys became GPO's system of record in December 2010.
- The FDsys public website provides users with access to hundreds of thousands of legislative, executive, and judicial documents.
- FDsys had its one billionth retrieval last month.

Drivers for NextGen

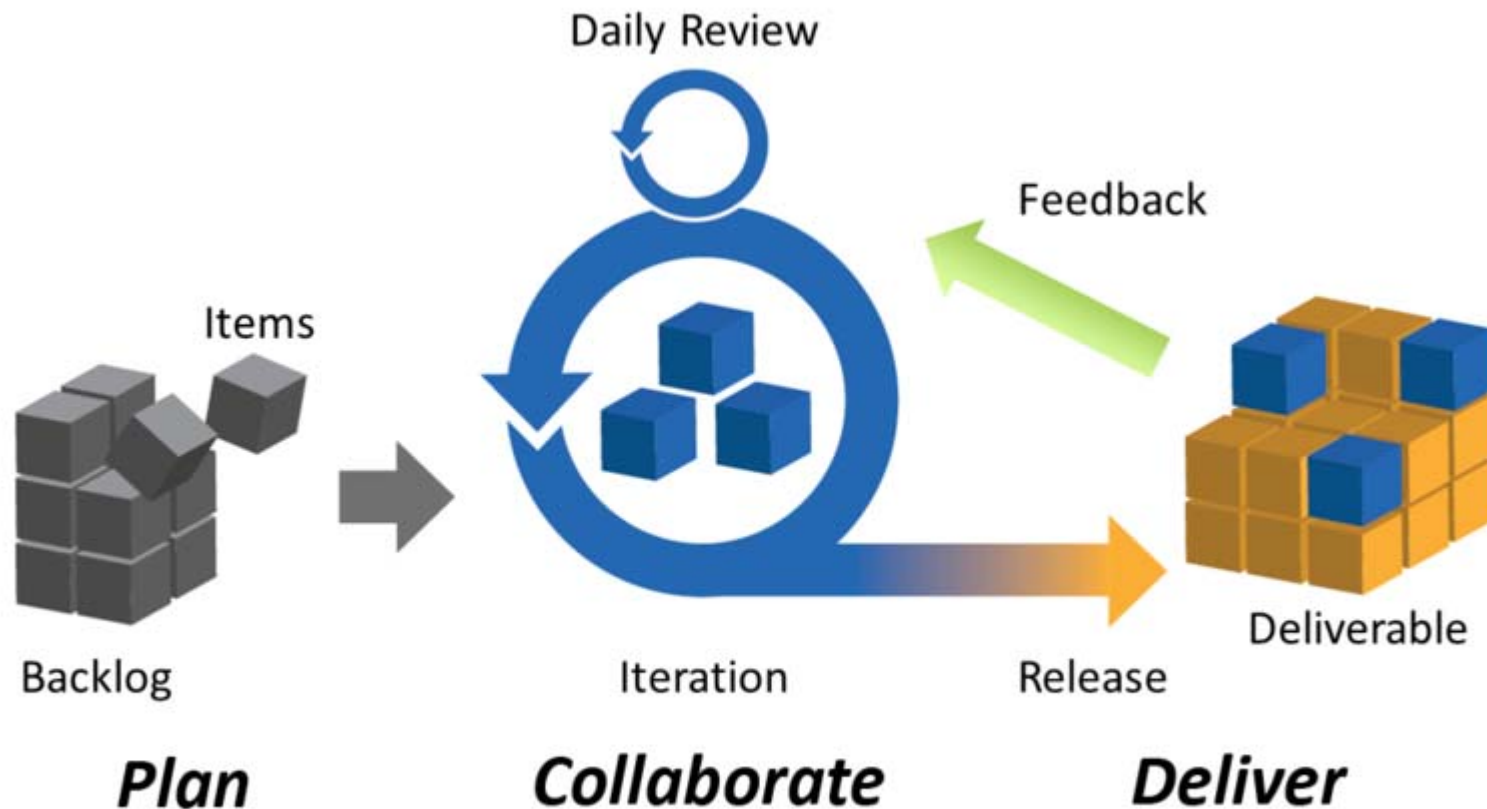
- Mainstream adoption of mobile technology
- Increase in use of social media and social sharing
- Maturity of semantic web and linked data technologies
- Search engine nearing end of life in FDsys environment
- Commitment to respond to user feedback and requests for updated functionality
- Importance of staying up-to-date with standard functionality provided by Government information websites

- Search Engine Refresh
- Publication Linking
- Usability Testing and User Interface Improvements

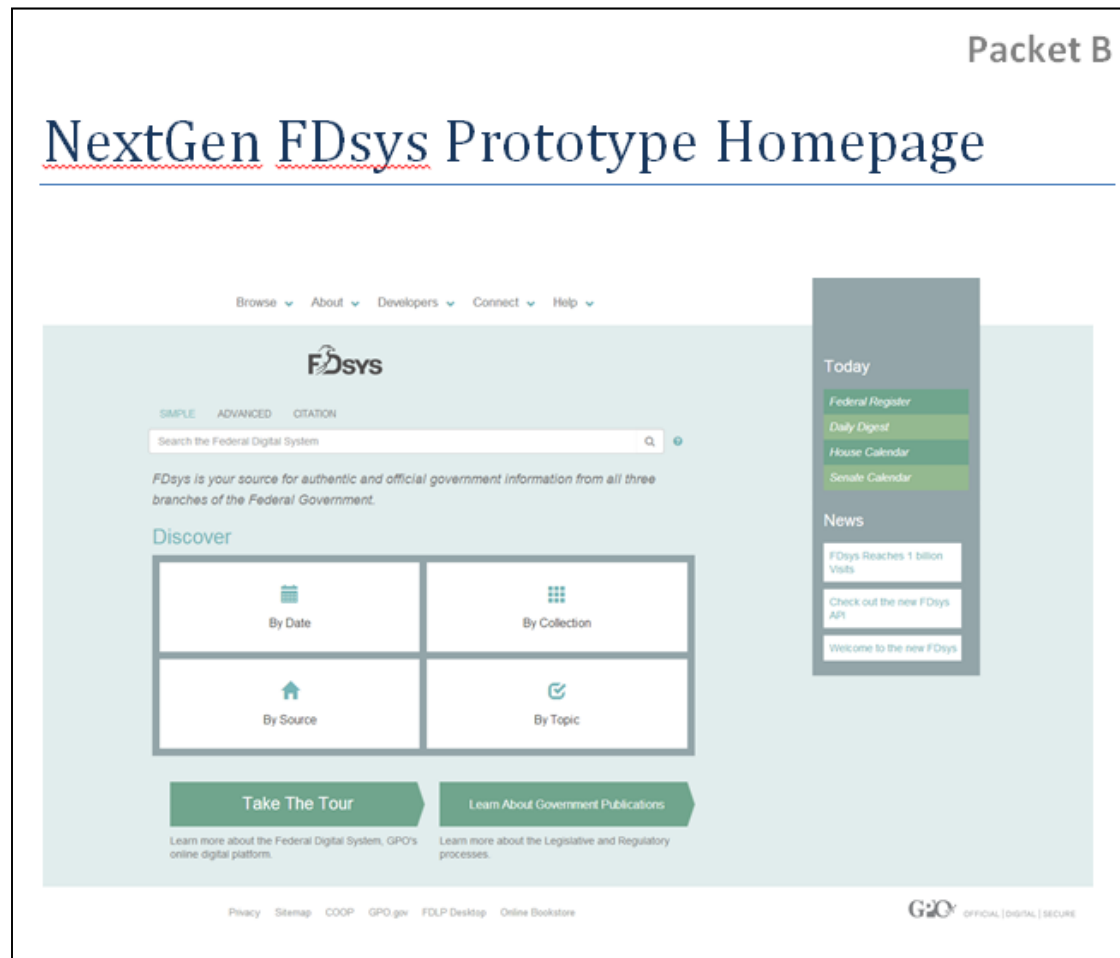
