INTRODUCTION

For each of the titles in the questionnaire that you indicate “Yes” you want to receive print, you will be asked to select your reason(s) for requesting the title. The reasons reflect the Criteria Questionnaire that was open for response from all Federal depository libraries from November 20-30, 2023.
