



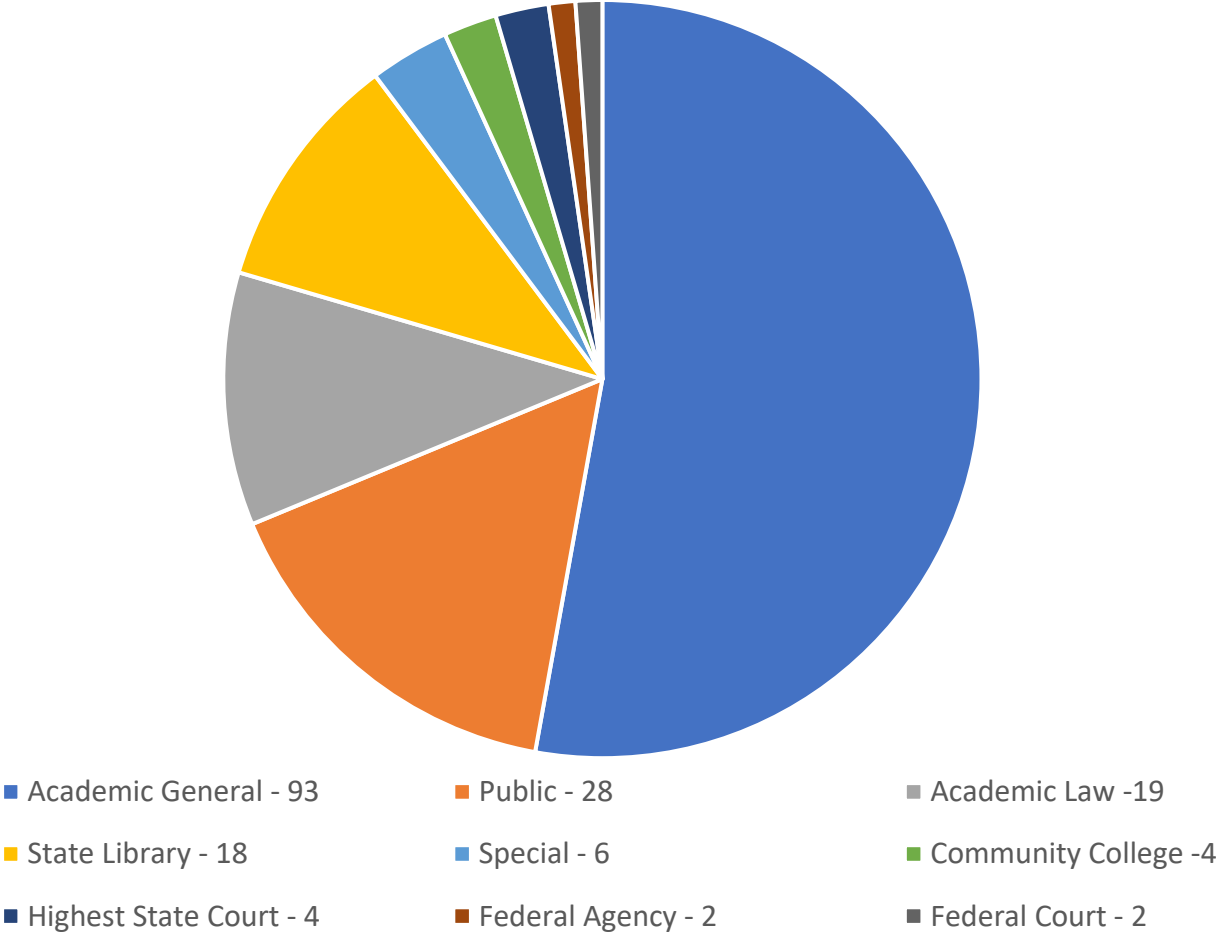

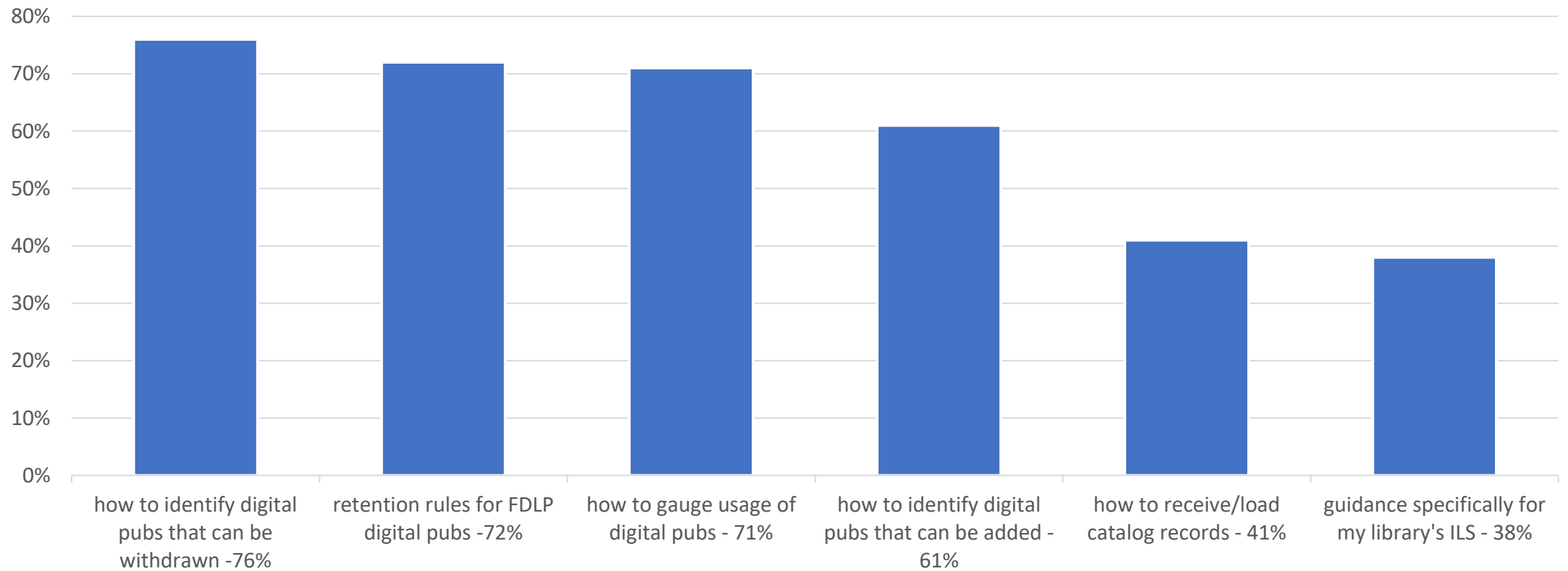

CDSS Survey - 176 Responses: Library Type

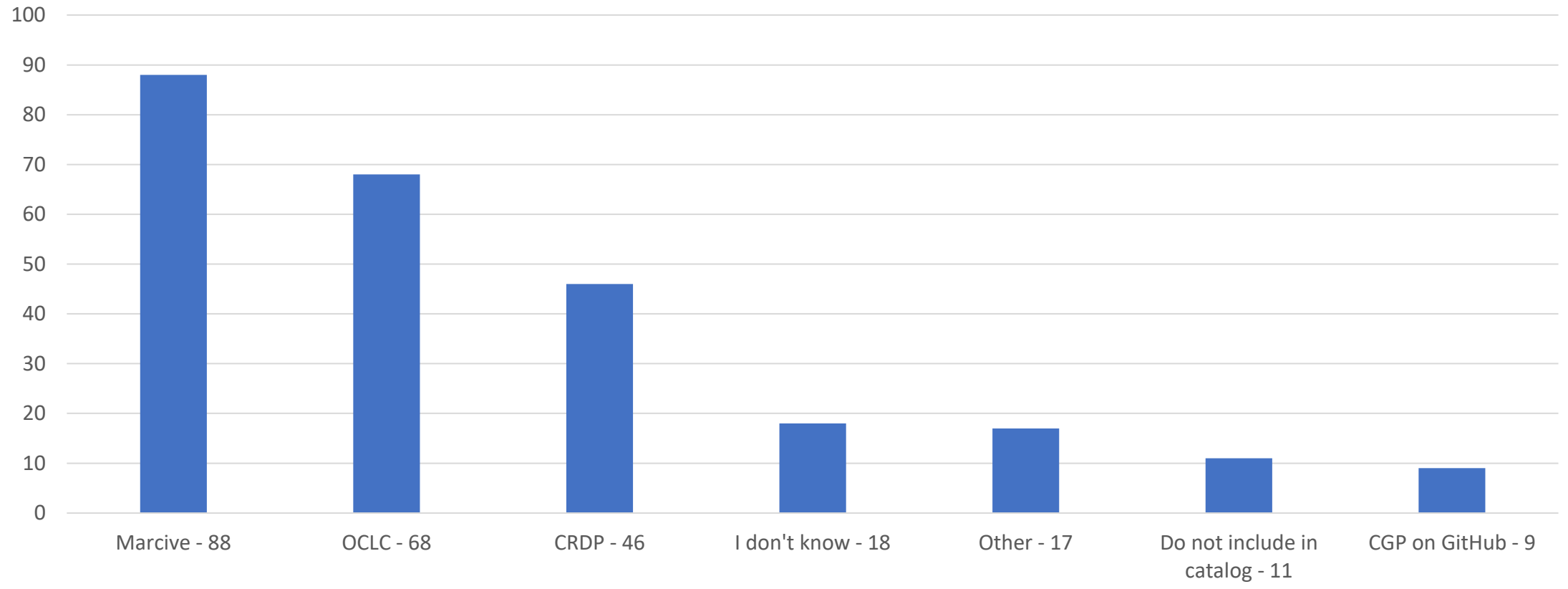

 use of about 15 student workers during this time

 process was sped up significantly over the past 2 years with new library expansion



New ways of sharing online government resources

- LibGuides (traditional, but made new)

- Beginning July 2025, New UNC Board of Governors directive for all UNC campuses (17 total) to teach “key concepts, principles, arguments, and contexts in founding documents of the American Republic, including the US Constitution, the Declaration of Independence, part of the Federalist Papers, Gettysburg Address, the Emancipation Proclamation, and the Letter from Birmingham jail, etc.

- Online/chat reference: students will ask how they can find resources on any given subject area. I’ll propose government resources. Ex: usa.gov and honeybees or congress.gov and “Indian Reorganization Act of 1934”
- Teach an Honor’s 110 Course themed on “Government Resources and Information.” (students required to take this course as Freshmen, different sections are themed on different subjects). Captive audience for 16 weeks, twice a week!
