Cost

How much will it cost for staff AND the number of hours needed to get this project done.



6 Parts of the project

- Remove bound periodicals from Mezzanine
- Select GovPubs titles to be moved
- Catalog GovPubs titles to be moved.
- Move them to Mezzanine
- Compact the remaining collection on 1st floor
- Move & store specialized collections during construction - temporary



- Don't forget to submit a contingency plan to GPO when you are planning a move.




