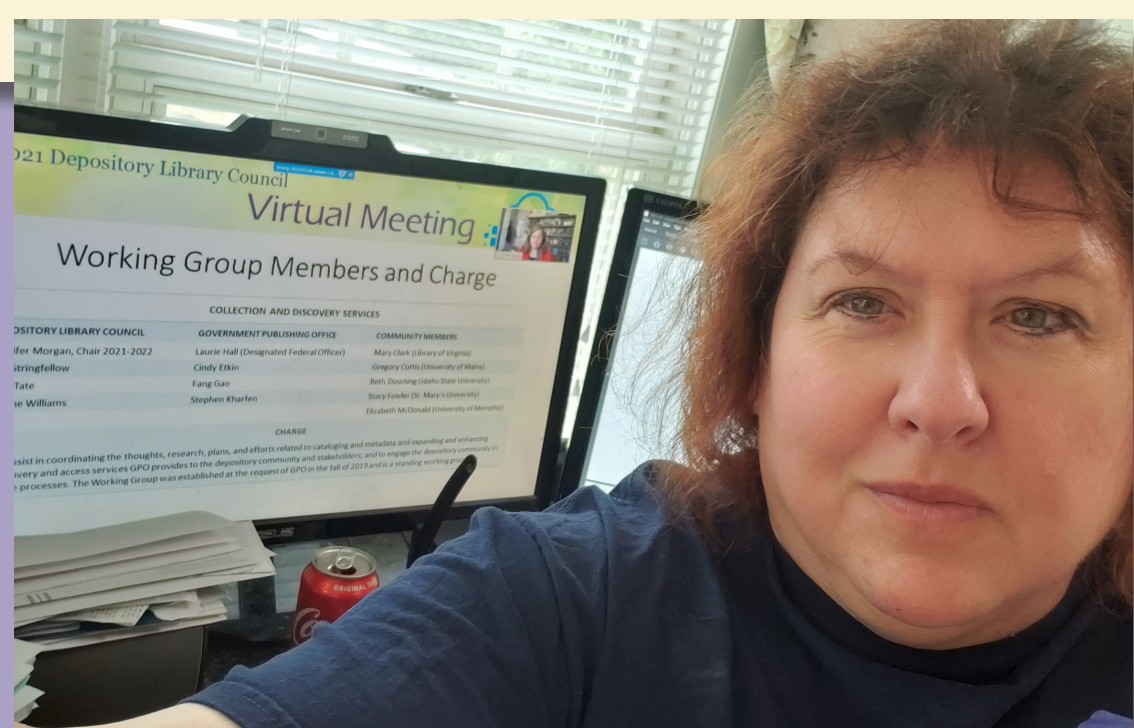


# Join Our Network of Contributors
