





#### General Information

The Government Publishing Office (GPO) makes its cataloging records available to libraries in several ways. Consult with your library's or consortia's cataloging, metadata, or systems staff to determine how to integrate catalog records into your local workflow or to modify an existing workflow. You may catalog as many or as few digital resources as needed for your users. Cataloging is only required for physical FDLP materials received at your library.

Your library may also consider non-cataloging options for digital content management, such as curated LibGuides, web pages, and development of digital collections. How your library decides to provide access to online Federal government resources is up to you.




## Pilot Projects 1 and 2

- Pilot Project 1
  - Cataloged approximately 600 monograph and 40 serial online version records to support the GovInfo ingest process.
  - Developed a method to create records for issues of serials and provided over 400 issue-level records.
- Pilot Project 2
  - Working on the cataloging and processing of the online version records.
  - Provided the 40 records for the first batches of digitized manuals.



## Serial Set Project

- Current CGP records data:
  - 30,265 records
  - 29,984 monographs
  - 281 serials
- Complete the records for the publications available on GovInfo.
  - 108,000 publications
  - 101,000 monographs
  - 7,000 serial issues
- Post the new records on GitHub.
- Update the records in OCLC with the GPO PURLs.





## Bills and Resolutions

- Generate MARC records for House and Senate bills and resolutions from the metadata of the GovInfo Congressional Bills Collection.
- Cataloged as integrating resources based on the introduced versions of the bills and resolutions.
- Starting point for information about the versions that are published and the actions that occur during the legislative process.







## Digital Imaging Specifications

- Follow the Federal Agencies Digital Guidelines Initiative's <u>"Technical Guidelines for Digiting Cultural Heritage Materials"</u> three-star level.
- Additional specifications include (exact specifications may differ based on the content being digitally imaged):
  - 400 ppi (original document size) with 24-bit RGB color.
  - o Master file format: JPEG 2000 with up to a 20:1 lossless compression ratio.
  - Searchable and optimized PDFs compliant to the PDF/A2-b format specification standard.
  - OCR text saved as .txt file format for each publication.
  - o Pages should have no visible skew (no more than between 0-1 degrees)
  - $\circ$  Pages cropped so the page edge is showing with a border of no less than 1/16 inch and no larger than  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch.





## Pilot Project 1

- Project with Utah State University (USU) Merrill-Cazier Library focusing on FDR-era Civil Defense documents
- Project team consists of USU Libraries and LSCM staff
- Cataloging and digitization for 1160 titles with overall goals of providing public access to project titles via <u>GovInfo</u> and <u>CGP</u> records
- Records have been added to CGP: Expert search WLTS=PILOTPROJECT1USU
- Digitized titles will be available on GovInfo in November

## Pilot Project 2 – UNT Libraries

- Pilot Project 2 with University of North Texas (UNT) Libraries began in July 2022.
- Project team consists of UNT Libraries and LSCM staff.
- Project plan includes inventory, condition assessment, and digital imaging for 643 World War II era military technical manuals in the W 1.25 and M 101.18 SuDoc classes, with overall goals of providing public access to those publications via <u>GovInfo</u>, <u>UNT Digital Library</u>, and <u>CGP</u> records.
- UNT PP2 titles will be included in the UNT Libraries <u>Preservation Steward</u> collections.
- Current project activities include creating CGP records and managing the digital-imaging process that is ongoing with the digitization vendor.

## OAM's Web Archiving Process

- 1. <u>Content Selection</u>: Identifying important Federal websites and online publications.
- **2.** <u>Automated Capture:</u> Using web crawler tools to capture snapshots of Federal sites.
- 3. <u>Data Storage:</u> Archiving content in secure, long-term repositories.
- **4.** <u>Metadata Management:</u> Adding description and classification for easy access.
- 5. **Quality Assurance:** Reviewing archived data to ensure completeness and accuracy.
- **6.** <u>Access:</u> Archived content available through the Catalog of U.S. Government Publications (CGP).









### **FDLP Web Archive**

- The FDLP Web Archive is specific to website level archiving. It provides point-in-time captures of U.S. Federal agency websites, while preserving the functionality of the site to the best extent possible, with an aim to provide permanent public access.
- Continue to increase the size of the FDLP Web Archive, still concentrating on recrawls of existing websites, while adding some new ones.
- Requests or questions can be made through askGPO, under the FDLP Web Archive category.










## End of Term (EOT) Web Archive






