Dear Federal Depository Coordinator:

In summer 2015, the U.S. Government Publishing Office (GPO)'s congressional oversight committee, the Joint Committee on Printing (JCP), approved the proposed Superintendent of Documents policy allowing regional depository libraries to discard depository materials that meet specified criteria.

Read GPO Director Davita Vance-Cooks' discard policy approval request and the JCP response to it.

In September 2016, regional depository libraries will be able to begin requesting permission to discard.

As part of this process, GPO is also recruiting libraries (both regionals and selectives) that will serve as Preservation Stewards. These designated libraries, under a Memorandum of Agreement with GPO, would retain all or a portion of discard-eligible depository resources. Identifying Preservation Stewards will allow GPO to ensure that preservation copies of record will be in geographically dispersed locations in the United States, as required by the JCP. If your library may be interested in serving as a Preservation Steward or you would simply like to learn more, register to attend our virtual discussion on August 2, 2016 from 2:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. (Eastern). By attending this virtual discussion, you are in no way committing to serve as a Preservation Steward. This is simply an exchange of information.
