Total Registrants by Location

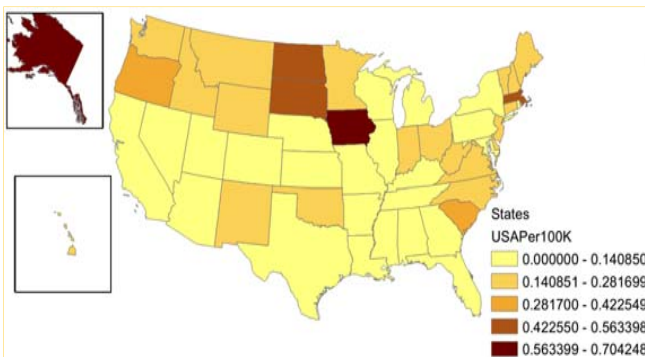
