Next Steps: Development of Guides to Help Librarians

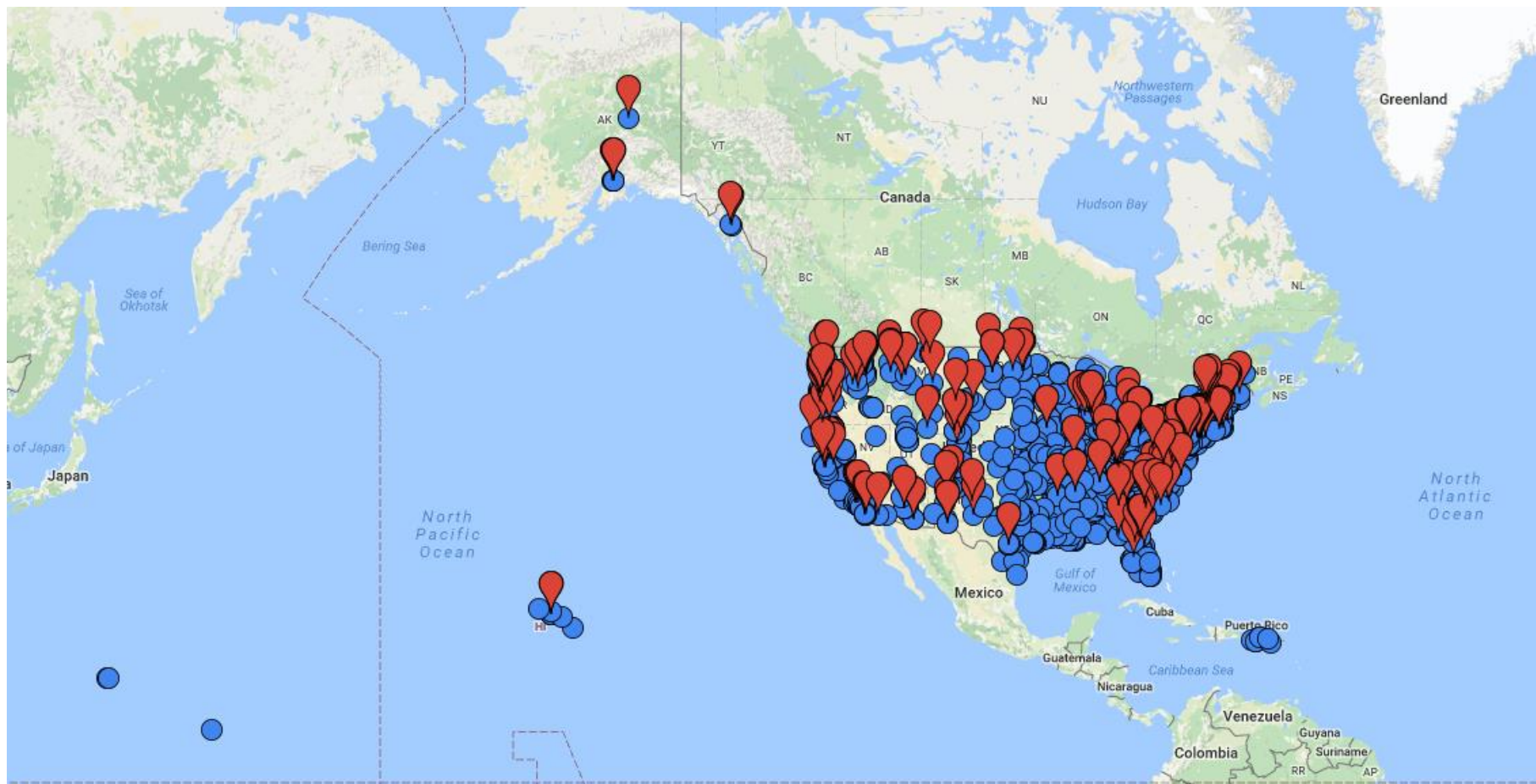
Development of briefing materials; handouts; and quick, how-to guides aimed to assist librarians that wear many hats. May include:

- Quick guides for effective searching of the CGP
- Quick tips for making item selection profile changes
- Promotional materials that clearly explain the benefits of participating in the FDLP
- Materials highlighting the benefits of digital depository libraries
- Working with depository librarians to develop subject guides based on service-centric collection requirements that would be available electronically as a quick resource

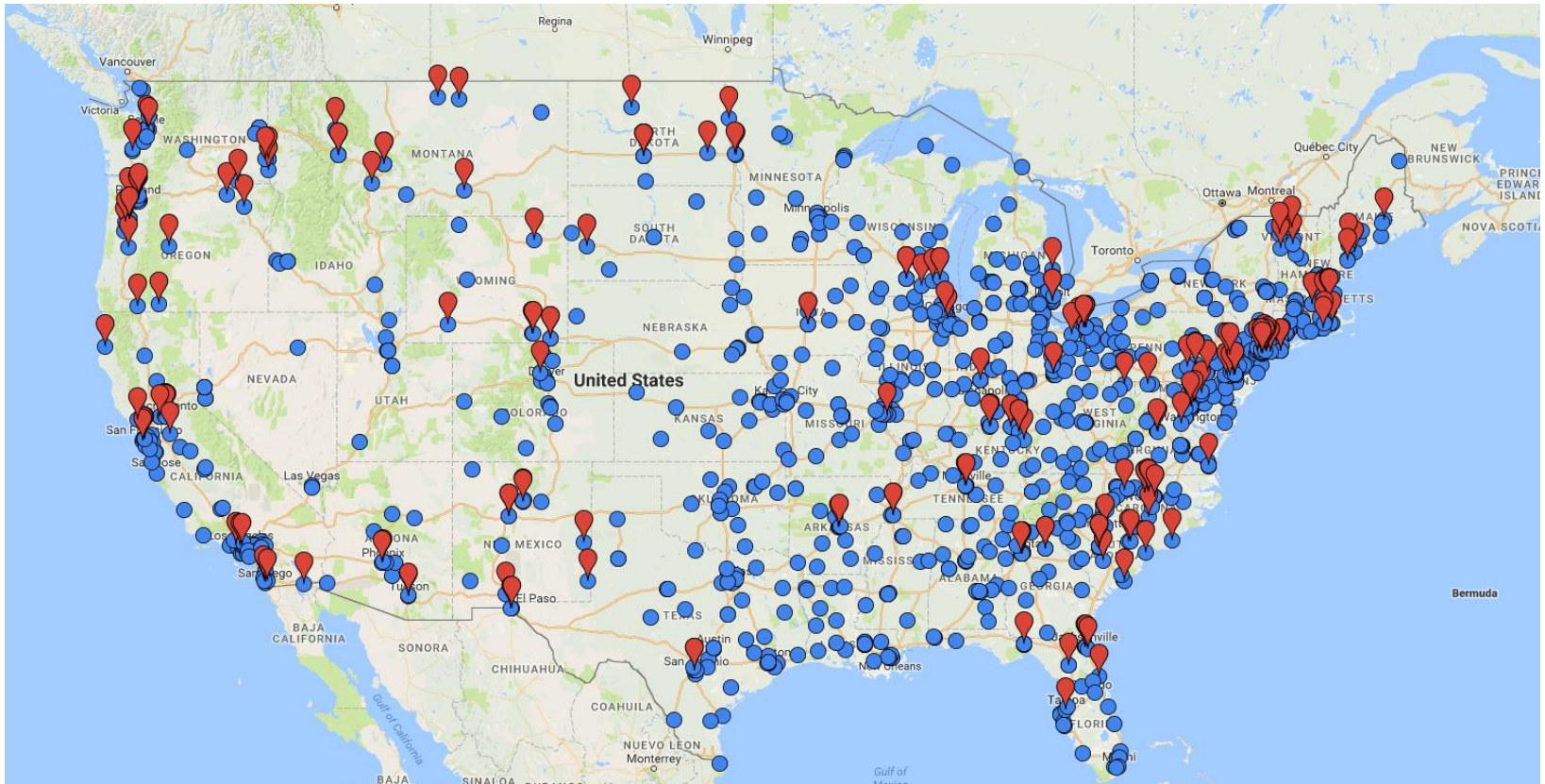
