The Statistics and Metrics Working Group (SAM) is convened to research, to report on, and to recommend options for how GPO can collect usage statistics from depository libraries for digital and tangible Government information products. Further, the Working Group is to study and report on the broader landscape of library data gathering trends and recommend possible programmatic library-related performance indicators.

Usage Statistics Survey Data (2022-25)

30 institutions supplied usage statistics of tangible materials from fall 2025 survey

- 19 universities
- 7 state, national, or law libraries
- 4 public libraries

Analysis: usage of the collections across all institutions increase significantly over this period

- Sample size not large enough to make any extrapolations to all 1,150 Federal depository libraries

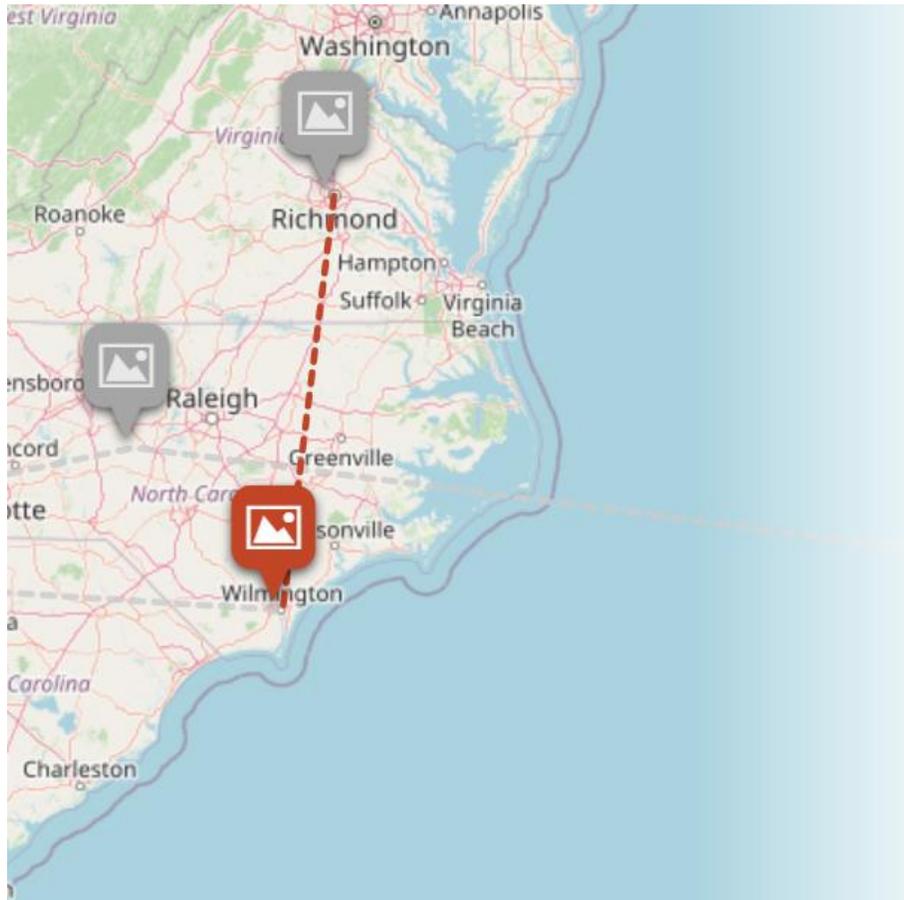
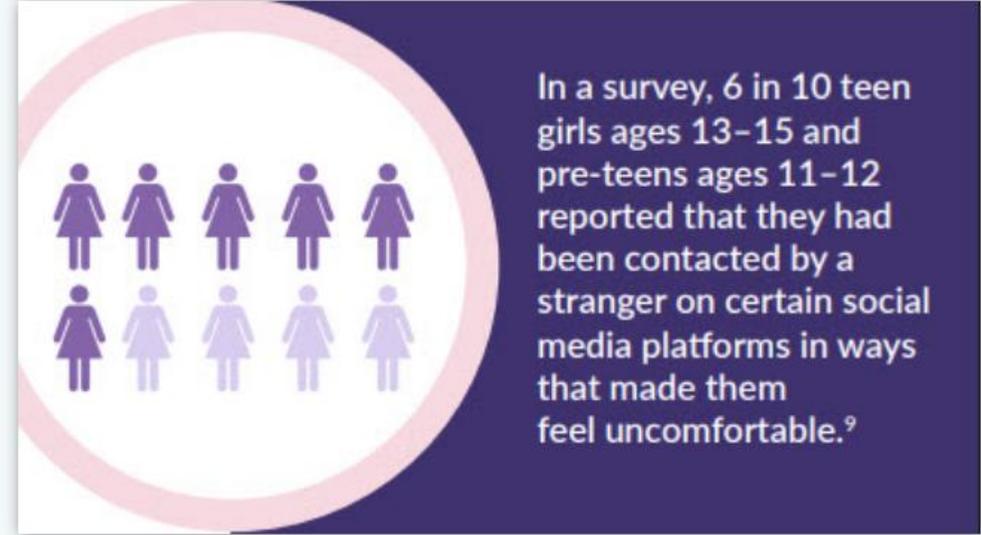

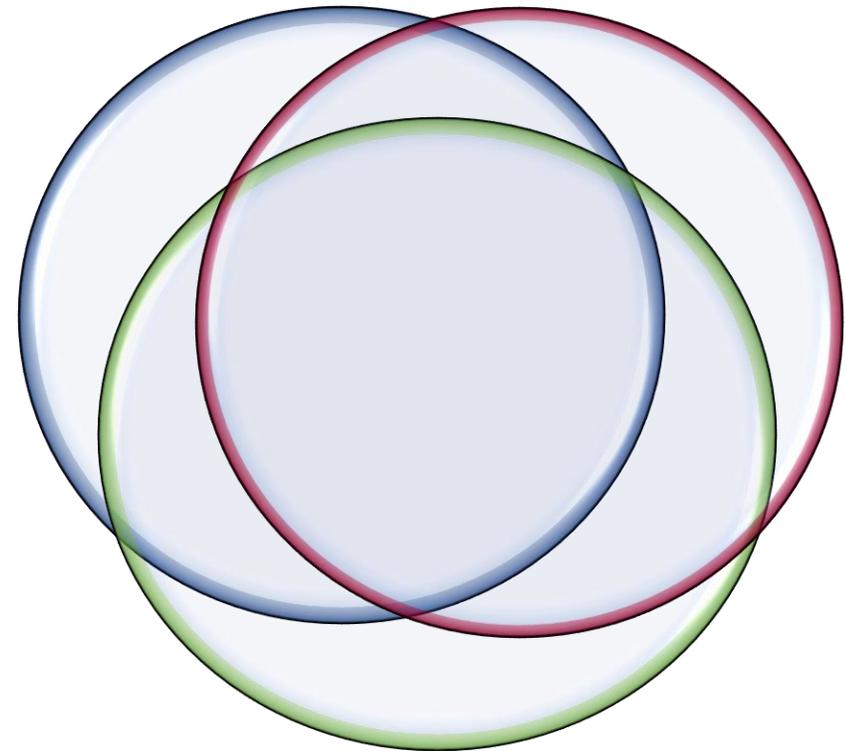

Digital-first

“§ 1909. Requirements of depository libraries; reports on conditions; consultations and training; termination; replacement

“(a) Only a library able to provide access to, custody of, and services for deposited materials **or** access to and services for online digital content and located in an area where it can best serve the public need may be designated as a depository library. The designated depository libraries shall report to the Superintendent of Documents at least every two years concerning their condition.

Flexibility

“§ 1911. Free use of Government public information in depositories; disposal of unwanted Government public information

“(a) FREE USE BY THE PUBLIC.—Depository libraries shall, pursuant to standards established by the Superintendent of Documents, make Government public information accessible for free use by the public.

“(c) DISPOSAL.—A depository library not served by a regional depository library, or that is a regional depository library, may dispose of unwanted Government public information in accordance with Superintendent of Documents policy and guidance.”

Purpose

“§ 1900. Purpose and establishment of the public information programs of the Superintendent of Documents

“(a) The purposes of this chapter are the following:

“(1) To ensure the public’s right to free, equitable, and convenient access to Government public information.

“(2) To establish the Public Information Programs of the Superintendent of Documents in the Government Publishing Office, that together, function to identify, acquire, catalog, preserve, authenticate, disseminate, reformat, and provide no-fee permanent public access to the corpus of Government public information for future generations, including the following programs and activities:

Suggestion from ALA

“(e) Protecting user privacy.—The Director of the Government Publishing Office, acting through the Superintendent of Documents, shall implement measures to protect the privacy of individuals using the digital repository described in subsection (d), and shall ensure that such measures provide users with at least the same level of privacy as provided under section 552a of title 5 (commonly known as the Privacy Act of 1974) and section 208 of the E–Government Act of 2002 (Public Law 107–347; set out as a note under section 3501 of this title).

“(f) Removal of public Government information from National Collection.—The Superintendent of Documents shall publicly disclose online, not less than annually, a list of any public Government information removed from public access in the National Collection or the digital repository described in subsection (d), and the reasons for such removals.

Council's Recommendation 1

Develop print-on-demand services

The Council recognizes that many users of Government information continue to experience challenges related to the digital divide. It recommends that GPO consider developing print-on-demand services for FDLs, enabling them to provide Government information to users who cannot access digital documents or reside far from a Federal Depository Library. The Council further recommends that the GPO consider ways to support interlibrary loan services to ensure the availability of printed documents to underserved populations.

GPO Response to Recommendation 1

GPO thanks Council for addressing the needs of those who are caught in the digital divide. It has been a few years since GPO last investigated the feasibility of providing print on demand. While GPO continues to invest in equipment that can support low-volume printing, the binding process continues to be a hurdle for truly economical print on demand. GPO is continuing to evaluate technical solutions as it purchases equipment, with the hope of delivering this capability at a cost-effective level in the future.

GPO Response to Recommendation 1

(Continued)

GPO understands that there are a number of interlibrary loan (ILL) networks in existence. Additionally, there are library consortia with active interlibrary loan services. ILL is a topic for discussion in the National Collection Service Area Steering Committees as they develop their comprehensive collection development and management plans. GPO plans to include holdings information for some collections in the Catalog of Government Publications. This will simplify identifying ILL lending libraries.

Council's Recommendation 2

Increase outreach with a public-facing toolkit

In a digital-first environment, Government information is accessed both within and outside of FDLs. To increase outreach and awareness to underserved populations who may not visit FDLs, the Council recommends the GPO develop a communications toolkit for Government information in all formats that FDLs and the general public can utilize. The toolkit should include promotional content suitable for social media and online use, as well as the tangible materials currently available.

This year, Federal Depository Support Services will work with Web Content to develop a webpage that will provide a listing of the various types of training materials, including FDLP Academy webinars, webcasts, videos, Library Resource Guides, programs from conferences, and other training resources. A longer-term project is underway to enhance the FDLP Academy, including its web presence.
