Dear Depository Coordinator,

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) Executive Director for Operations has asked the Superintendent of Documents to recall selected microfiche from the NRC microfiche collection. These microfiche contain personally identifiable information (PII), i.e. information such as Social Security and bank account numbers that can be used to identify a person uniquely and reliably.

The microfiche to be removed were once part of the NRC's Local Public Document Room (LPDR) program. They came under the purview of the Federal Depository Library Program (FDLP) and transferred to your library in 2000 when the NRC discontinued the LPDR program. Though these microfiche were not distributed through the normal channels of the FDLP, they were assigned the SuDoc class stem Y 3.N 88:62/ under item 1051-H-45.

Please remove the following microfiche from your collection immediately and return them to the NRC by March 2, 2007. Use the self-addressed, postage paid envelope provided to you and include the enclosed card with your library's address.


