1901.	Definition of Government publication.
1902.	Availability of Government publications through Superintendent of Documents; lists of publications not ordered from Government Publishing Office.
1903.	Distribution of publications to depositories; notice to Government components; cost of printing and binding.
1904.	Classified list of Government publications for selection by depositories.
1905.	Distribution to depositories; designation of additional libraries; justification; authorization for certain designations.
1906.	Land-grant colleges constituted depositories.
1907.	Libraries of executive departments, service academies, and independent agencies constituted depositories; certifications of need; disposal of unwanted publications.
1908.	American Antiquarian Society to receive certain publications.
1909.	Requirements of depository libraries; reports on conditions; investigations; termination; replacement.
1910.	Designations of replacement depositories; limitations on numbers; conditions.
1911.	Free use of Government publications in depositories; disposal of unwanted publications.

2017 Biennial Survey of Depository Libraries

- Survey ran from October 23 – November 30, 2017
- New – Region Reports
 - Compiled the data from all the libraries in a state/region
 - Were sent to regional depository coordinators in March 2018
 - Help identify collection development and statewide trends
- Data and Analysis
 - High level report – June 2018
 - Detailed report, analysis, and data release – late summer 2018

Legal Requirements & Program Regulations of the Federal Depository Library Program



February, 2018 revised edition

- Rescinded regulation 10 from the 2011 edition, a previous requirement to select two item numbers associated with tangible distribution
 - 0556-C and 1004-E are now inactivated item numbers
- Replaced FDLP-L with FDLP News and Events
- Included the Regional Discard Policy
- Updated FDLP decal graphics

Official File Scanning Project

- Project is digitizing all documents in depository official files
- These records contain designation documents, correspondence, inspections, Biennial Surveys and other official FDLP documentation
- Scanning will provide a single PDF of all contents and copies of individual documents which will be available electronically

Cataloging Record Distribution Program

- Provides GPO produced catalog records to participating Federal depository libraries at no cost to the libraries, through a contract with MARCIVE, Inc.
- Catalog records may be:
 - Based on each individual library's item number selection profile
 - Historic Shelflist records
- Participation in the CRDP is currently limited to 180 libraries

Cataloging Record Distribution Program

- Reminder: Currently participating libraries may:
 - Update their FDLP item number selections anytime
 - Contact GPO for a CRDP Buddy, a fellow practitioner at another CRDP library, ideally with the same library system
 - Contact MARCIVE personnel when they need to update their CRDP Profile or have technical questions

Cataloging Guidelines Update

- Most significant recent change: Bibliographic Cataloging: Overview
- Expanded explanation and clarification of the authoritative status of the Catalog of U.S. Government Publications (CGP)
- CGP is the source of the official version of GPO's bibliographic records
- GPO maintains its records primarily in the CGP

Superintendent of Documents Classification Guidelines

- Coming soon to FDLP.gov
- Revision of 1993 *GPO Classification Manual*
- Accessible, easy to update, and increases visibility of policy
- Team effort across LSCM staff

Superintendent of Documents Classification Guidelines

- Table of contents expand to display article sections
- SuDocs examples link to CGP records; most have PURLs to full-text content
- Time stamp reflects latest update
- Print-friendly pages

Copyright Information in Bibliographic Records

GPO's Proposal in Response to DLC Recommendation Fall 2017

- 1:** Council recommends that the Library Services and Content Management division explore using MARC field 542 to define the copyright status of government publications.

Implementation Plan

- Finalize details of the plan
- Review process
 - Internal Review Process
 - External Review Process
- Two-phased approach
 - **First Phase:**
 - From the date of initial implementation, add the 542 field only to bibliographic records new to the CGP
 - Provisional date of initial implementation: **October 2018**
 - **Second phase:**
 - Add the 542 to existing CGP records determined appropriate after the date of the initial implementation


