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 **The Record Set**

Full set of bibliographic records for **online** resources cataloged by the U.S. Government Publishing Office (U.S. GPO) in support of the Federal Depository Library Program (FDLP) and the Cataloging & Indexing Program through the Catalog of Government Publications (CGP).

 **The Problem**

MARCIVE ceased operations and the CRDP program terminated in December 2024, leaving depository libraries without essential batch record delivery services for GPO e-resources.

 **Goal**

Reduce workload for libraries needing U.S. G.P.O e-resource bibliographic records in their catalogs for FDLP compliance and patron support.

 **Outcome**

Established automated ingestion pipeline filtering GPO's record set, extracting 222,000+ e-resource records into Alma Community Zone ("U.S. Federal Government Documents from US GPO").

Project Summary

This project addressed a critical infrastructure need for libraries managing Federal Depository Library Program (FDLP) collections following the cessation of MARCIVE services and the conclusion of the OCLC Cataloging and Retrieval Distribution Program (CRDP). Spearheaded by Jill Strykowski (San José State University) in advocacy and technical partnership with the U.S. Government Publishing Office (U.S. GPO) and Ex Libris/Clarivate Content Management team, the initiative transitions Alma-using libraries to an automated, Ex Libris-managed Alma Community Zone (CZ) collection.

By establishing a direct, automated monthly ingestion pipeline from GPO’s GitHub repositories into the Alma CZ, the project provides FDLP libraries, and others using the Alma ILS, with updated, high-quality online MARC records for U.S. Federal Government Documents published online, without requiring additional subscriptions, manual file exports, or complex local overlay routines.

The Matchmaking Role

Convening Leaders

Conducted a 2-year dialogue with GPO record users, finally bringing together ExLibris product managers and the U.S. GPO metadata leadership team.

Technical Alignment

GPO GitHub data was examined, amended and harmonized with Alma Community Zone ingestion rules, by establishing clean e-resource filtering and identifier codes.

Community Advocacy

Communicated and helped troubleshoot user metadata needs through GODORT, CSU forums, UC groups, and other U.S. depositories.

Two-Year Project Timeline

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May 2023: Alma CZ Community encounters import issues

Influx of duplicate U.S. Federal Documents titles in Alma CZ collection, prompts user calls for ExLibris-managed updates.

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Oct. 2024: MARCIVE/CRDP sunset announced; eCaug discussions

MARCIVE and OCLC sunset announcements lead to Ex Libris User Group of California (eCaug) proposition for ExLibris take on import/update work.

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Feb. 2026: Kickoff meeting & collaboration scope defined

After over a year of investigations into issues with original CZ collection, fact-finding discussions with Clarivate, and contact development with GPO, a project kickoff meeting is arranged, establishing formal collaboration.

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Mar. 2026: Automated ingestion pipeline & technical specs set

Ex Libris confirms ability to automate record loads from GPO GitHub. Consensus reached on an ~222,000 baseline snapshot of e-resources from CGP ([catalog.gpo.gov](#))

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Apr. 2026: GPO GitHub repo created; ExLibris import begins

GPO publishes dedicated e-resource repository on GitHub and ExLibris initiates full baseline data ingestion.

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June 2026: Collection fully available in Alma CZ

U.S. Federal Government Documents collection (Collection ID: 613170000000000069) is live and automated for all Alma CZ users.

Troubleshooting & Outreach Work

Scope: Coordination of ongoing troubleshooting and collaborative problem-solving was undertaken, spanning several months. This included investigating missing 074/086 metadata fields, analyzing record merging discrepancies between English and Spanish language editions, testing workaround procedures for selective activation, and addressing ticket escalations across multiple institutions.

In Process Perfecting & Workflows

- Metadata Enhancements & Field Troubleshooting:** Coordinating efforts to ensure necessary MARC fields—specifically the 074 (GPO Item Number) and 086 (SuDoc Number)—are correctly populated and enriched for selective activation. Discussions also addressed cataloging anomalies, such as missing Spanish-language versions and incorrect bibliographic record merging
- Selective Activation Workflows:** Developing and testing Alma workflows (proposed by Noam Fass) utilizing logical sets, full collection sets, and combined sets to automatically filter and prune portfolios based on institutional selection criteria (such as 008 state/country codes and 086 SuDoc prefixes).
- Knowledge Base Documentation:** Collaborating on a comprehensive Q&A knowledge base page addressing community inquiries regarding collection contents, monthly GitHub update schedules, selection profiles, error reporting via AskGPO/Clarivate Support, and CDI hybrid database behavior.

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
