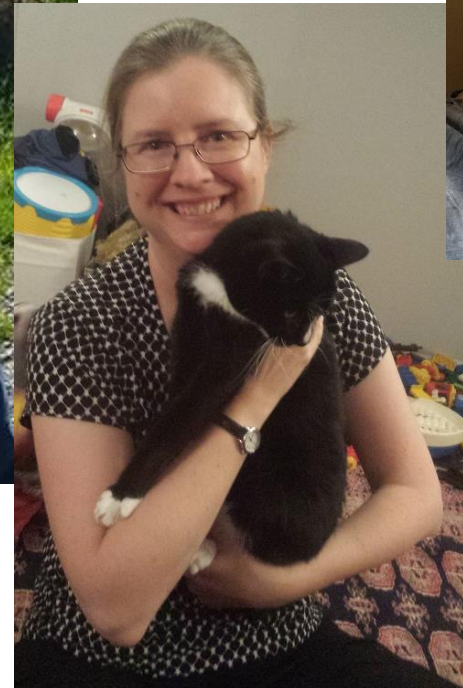

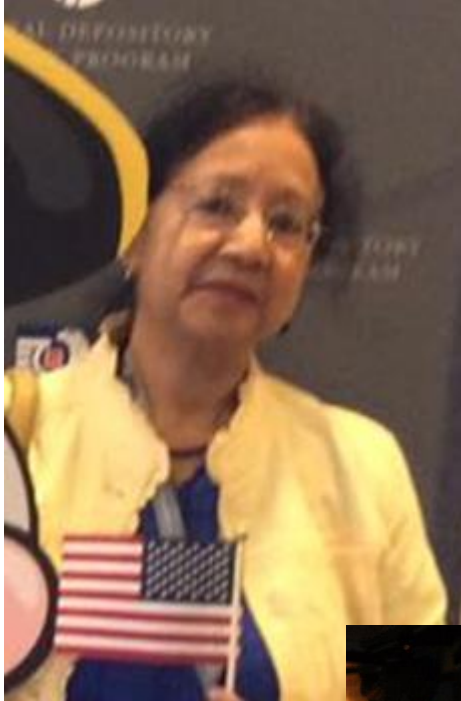

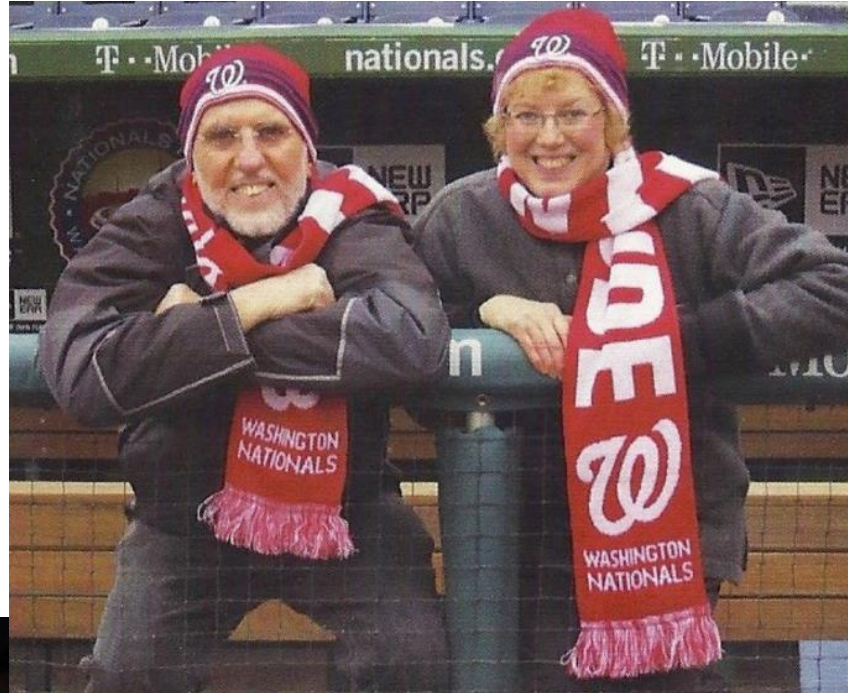

FDLP Summary

The purpose of the FDLP, in 11 words:

**Free, equitable access to Government
publications for everyone.**

Period.



Development of the FDLP (milestones)

1895 – GPO gets statutory responsibility.

Basic operating rules are set in law.

1922 – Libraries become an active partner by being required to select what they receive.

1962 – Scope broadened, designation eligibility expanded

1993 – GPO Access Act



From then to now

- In the past we operated on a model that had GPO in an enforcement role. We kept tabs and did remediation.
- As the nature of the products we handle, as well as daily life in libraries, has changed, so has our approach. Now we try to operate such that **for every requirement or expectation placed on designated libraries, we offer support and services to help those libraries meet the need and ultimately give good service to the public.**



What does Outreach & Support do?

- Consult and provide advice
 - Phone, email, askGPO
 - Visits
 - Individual service
- Help work through processes, issues, and concerns
- Facilitate connections and networking
- Work with single libraries and with groups of libraries

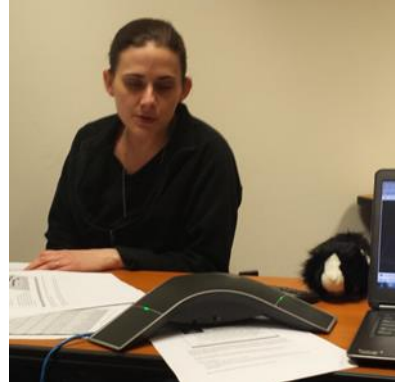

Q&A: FDLP Administration at Your Library

- What do I need to do if there is a new Coordinator?
- What year did my library join the FDLP?
- What can I do if a public patron entered the library saying they wish to use depository resources but are not doing so?
- What is my FDLP password? How do I get it?
- The former Coordinator's contact info appears in FDLP.gov, DSIMS, or the PURL Usage Reporting Tool. How do I change that?
- How can I get some of those cool square pencils or other FDLP promotional materials?



Q&A: Collection Development

- Can GPO provide me with a list of my selections, including item number, title, SuDocs class number, and format?
- How can I figure out if a title has been distributed recently?
- Why hasn't a title been distributed recently if it is 'active' in the List of Classes?
- I want to go all or mostly digital (or my administration wants me to). How does that work?
- How do I know if there is an online equivalent for a tangible item that I want to deselect?
- How do I identify online publications for cataloging?



Q&A: Collection Maintenance

- How do I stop this microfiche? I deselected it ages ago.
- GPO, can you confirm that I can supersede a particular publication?
- Shipments are going to the wrong place. How do I fix it?
- Can I give a superseded publication to another branch library in our system?
- Why do I keep getting shipping lists when we don't get very many paper publications?



Q&A: Collection Maintenance

- Can GPO send me a list of what you shipped to my library over the years?
- I made claims for missing Congressional Record daily pubs some weeks ago. Why haven't they been sent?
- Where is information about the FDLP eXchange?
- How do I access the FDLP eXchange?
- How do I get my eXchange password?

- How do I get an FDLP Academy Certificate?
