Although the modern **govinfo** website is replacing the legacy FDsys website, GPO remains committed to ensuring authenticity, integrity, and preservation of more than a million Federal documents. This includes the application of digital signatures on PDF files and operation of the **govinfo** repository as an ISO 16363 Trustworthy Digital Repository.

Enhanced Access with govinfo

FDsys and **govinfo** are websites that provide access to the same repository of content, but **govinfo** has new features, an intuitive design, and exciting enhancements—see reverse!

Links and PURLs Will Be Redirected

Upon retirement, links to FDsys, including PURLs, will be redirected to **govinfo** resources. GPO aims to ensure links are redirected as close as possible to the equivalent **govinfo** resource.
