



Under the authority of the Trading With the Enemy Act, as amended, Executive Order 9193, as amended, and Executive Order 9788, and pursuant to law, after investigation, it is hereby found:
1. That Hiroyuki Amano and Teruno Amano, whose last known address is Japan, are residents of Japan and nationals of a designated enemy country (Japan);
2. That the domiciliary personal representatives, heirs, next of kin, legatees and distributees, names unknown, of Takasuke Amano, deceased, who there is reasonable cause to believe are residents of Japan, are nationals of a designated enemy country (Japan);
3. That the net proceeds due or to become due under a contract of insurance evidenced by policy No. 9 008 803, issued by the New York Life Insurance Company, New York, New York, to Takasuke Amano, together with the right to demand, receive and collect said net proceeds,
is property within the United States owned or controlled by, payable or deliverable to, held on behalf of or on account of, or owing to, or which is evidence of ownership or control by, the aforesaid nationals of a designated enemy country (Japan);






19. Licenses

a. If you live in the Canal Zone your automobile must be registered in the Zone, while personnel residing in the Republic of Panama register their vehicles in Panama. Canal Zone plates cost \$5 per year for all makes of cars. The cost for Panamanian registrations is \$3.02 plus \$2 tax, or a total of \$5.02 annually. Dual registration is not permitted.

There were 62 cases of malaria admitted to hospital during September as against 124 for August and 143 for July.

Seventeen cases of dengue were admitted during September as against two for last month, the majority coming from Empire on the west side of the Canal.



AN ACT To authorize electronic surveillance to obtain foreign intelligence information.
