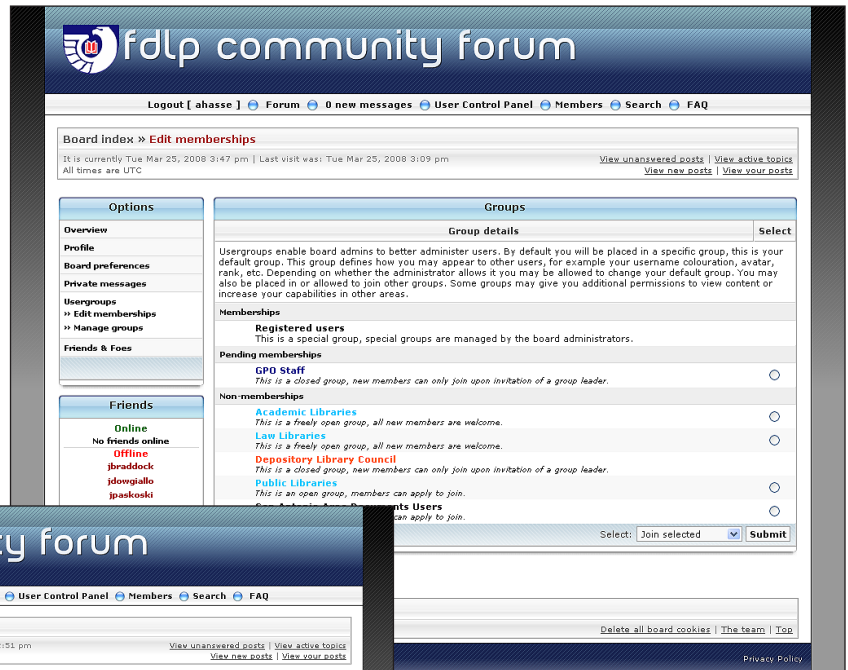

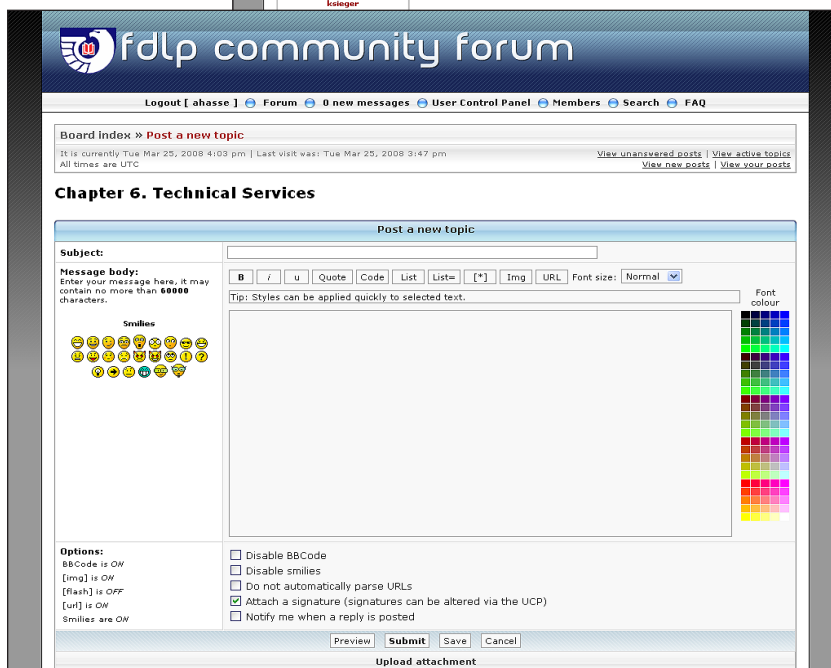
- Subscribe to threads and receive an email notification when your selected thread is active.
