<b>General Interest</b> (8) Includes current events, newsworthy topics, and reference materials that may not fit in any of the other established categories.	<b>Legal &amp; Regulatory</b> (12) Includes governing actions controlled by the law, as well as congressional documents, the Federal Register, nuclear regulations, et cetera.
<b>Natural Sciences &amp; Mathematics</b> (11) Includes botany, chemistry, zoology, mathematics, and other topics involving the study of the physical world and its phenomena.	<b>Social Sciences</b> (21) Includes documents and collections on American History, geography, political science, psychology, and sociology.
<b>Technology &amp; Applied Sciences</b> (8) Includes engineering (physics, materials, ceramics, opticals) electronics, artificial intelligence, and computer science.
