INFORMATION: To be eliqible for CDIB/Tribal Citizenship with the Cherokee Nation, you must be able to provide documents that connect you to an enrolled lineal ancestor, who is listed on the (DAWES ROLL) FINAL ROLLS OF CITIZENS AND FREEDMEN OF THE FIVE CIVILIZED TRIBES, Cherokee Nation. This roll was taken between 1899-1906 of Citizens and Freedmen residing in Indian Territory (now NE Oklahoma)

Many applicants do not qualify for CDIB/Citizenship as their ancestors did not meet the enrollment requirements and were not enrolled. Certain requirements had to be met in order to be placed on the Dawes Roll.

CDIB/Tribal Citizenship are issued through natural parents. In adoption cases, CDIB/Citizenship must be proven through the BIOLOGICAL PARENT to the enrolled ancestor. A copy of the Final Decree of Adoption, and a State Certified, Full Image/Photocopy of the Birth Record must accompany the application. All information will remain confidential.

INSTRUCTIONS & RESEARCH REFERRAL:

- 1. Complete the application/ancestry chart in ink and provide the following documents.
- 2. A parent or legal guardian may complete and sign the application/ancestry chart for minor child applicants and provide the following documents.
- 3. Attach the ORIGINAL STATE CERTIFIED FULL IMAGE/PHOTOCOPY OF THE BIRTH RECORD of the applicant and a copy of an immediate family member's CDIB/Citizenship card
- 4. If no one in the family has received CDIB/Citizenship, attach ORIGINAL STATE CERTIFIED DOCUMENTS (BIRTH/DEATH) CERTIFICATES beginning with the applicant back to the enrollee.
- 5. If your enrollee ancestor DIED after 1962, submit the ORIGINAL STATE CERTIFIED DEATH CERTIFICATE. This is needed to assist us in our review.
- 6. Mail the applications and the original documents to the Cherokee Nation Registration Department, Should further information be needed to complete the applications, we will contact you for specific documents.

Should we be unable to issue you CDIB/Citizenship, a letter of explanation will be sent to you by restricted/certified mail. An Appeals Process will accompany the letter, should you not agree with our findings/decision.

Processing time may vary. The Registration Department does not provide research services. You can do research on your computer or contact your local library for access to a computer to do your research on the internet:

FEDERAL E-GOVERNMENT WEBSITES E-government services in your library

Our definition of E-government for this workshop: online personal and business transactions.

- 1. What are the demands of a website upon the library?
 - a. Demands upon staff what level of service will you provide, and what level of training will your librarians and library staff need to provide it?
 - b. Demands upon computer and library network
- 2. Will you need to erect privacy screens for your customers who are working with personal information such as Social Security numbers?
- 3. You will need to disable popup blockers to work with most websites, and may need to work with your IT staff to be able to access some features of a website through your library computer system's firewall.
- 4. Will you restrict the number of hours that a customer can work upon any one computer? The number of days per week that they use your computers? Some e-government services require the use of a computer by one customer for several hours per day over several days per week. Will you allow your customers do this?
- 5. In order to access some E-government services, your customers will need to have their own e-mail accounts, and you will probably need to help them accomplish this.
- 6. You may have customers who attempt to use your computers to conduct their personal e-business transactions. Your library probably does not want them to do this. How will you prevent it?
- 7. If you don't provide a particular e-government service, is there another entity in your community that will? If so, you may not have to provide a service.
- 8. What is the public relations value to your library of providing access and service to a particular e-government tool? This may help you determine whether you offer access and service or not.

- 9. Remember that at this time you don't have to offer any e-government services—other than access and service for websites chosen as depository items--so it's up to your library to decide what level of access and service for particular websites, and the days and times you'll offer e-government access and services. Providing e-government services enhances your FDLP program, and can serve as an entry point to your traditional FDLP services.
- 10. You will need to keep up with new e-government services by monitoring important federal websites and scanning national and local newspapers.
- 11. As with legal or medical services, never give advice about e-government services or your library could be held liable for your mistakes.
- 12. In order to provide even basic services for E-government online tools, you'll need to learn to use them yourself, and know not only the basic ways to use these online tools, but also know how to use all of their optional features.
- 13. Expect change in e-government services from federal agencies to be constant and continual. You will need to constantly check the websites for which you offer e-government access and service.
- 14. When you offer E-government services in your library you're making the transition from "Depository Collection" to "Government Information Services Center" whether you realize it or not.
- 15. If delivering E-government services is one of the strategies that you need to offer for your FDLP collection to survive at all, can you afford to *not* offer E-government services?

E~GOVERNMENT INTRODUCTION

This is taken from *State and Federal E-Government in the United States, 2007* by Dr. Darrell West, Brown University, Taubman Center for Public Policy, published August 2007

*86% percent of state and federal websites have services that are "FULLY EXECUTABLE PERSONAL OR BUSINESS ONLINE TRANSACTIONS". 58% websites have three or more services, 13% have two services, 15% have one service, and only 14% have no services. Term to remember here: "FULLY EXECUTABLE ONLINE," a phrase that you will see increasingly if your library offers E-government resources and services. It is The Gold Standard of E-government.

- * 56% of government websites are written at a 12th grade reading level, BUT the reading level of the average American is 8th grade or lower. Idea to remember here: THE PROBLEM THIS CREATES MAY BECOME PART OF OUR JOB SECURITY AS LIBRARIES BECOME THE "INFORMATION SAFETY NET" IN THEIR COMMUNITIES.
- * 22% of websites offer some type of foreign language translation, which is DOWN from 30% last year. Idea to remember: as the U.S. becomes more multi-culti, we need MORE not LESS translation, so this trend is bad. Has the English-only movement hurt foreign language translation?
- * 89% of websites have E-mail addresses that customers can use to contact someone at the agency. But there's no guarantee IF or HOW SOON they'll get a reply.

- *44% of websites have message boards, chat services, and/or online surveys.
- *Quote from report: "One of the most promising aspects of e-government is its ability to bring citizens closer to their governments." (page 9).
