
WebCT Homepage

- **Calendar** - beginning and closing dates for tests, TNG, and homework



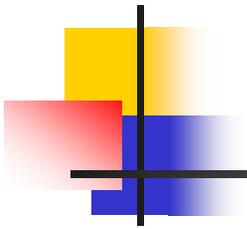

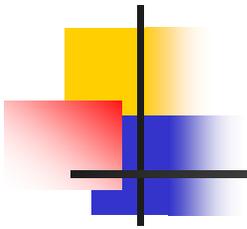
Government Depository Information

- Access to materials not available to non-depository libraries



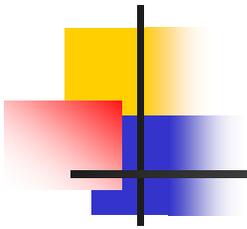

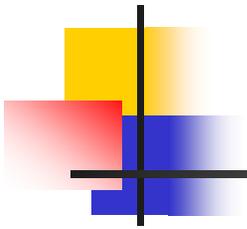
Internet Searching

- Domain names – edu, gov, mil, com, org
- Types of search engines
 - General – Google
 - Directories - Yahoo
 - Meta Search engines – Metacrawler
 - Subject – About.com
- Boolean searching
 - And - Or – Not
- Creating search strategies
 - Stop words
 - “Real term” searching
 - Broaden / narrow searches



Website Evaluation

- Authorship
 - Name – cite sources – ask questions
- Purpose
 - Clarity – advertising - biases
- Design & Stability
 - Ease of use – design - updates
- Content
 - Appropriate – current - looks




