### Public Law 103-40: Requirements

 Online Federal Register and Congressional Record; other databases determined by Superintendent of Documents

✓ A Federal information locator

 Electronic Storage Facility for Federal Information



### GPO Access: Goals and Objectives

 Improve access to Federal Government information in electronic formats

- Provide easy to use online services that are available to the public
- Provide official and comprehensive information
- Provide Federal-wide Resources
- Ensure access to broadest audience possible
- Electronic information is a byproduct of the print process
- Ensure Permanent Public Access (PPA)


