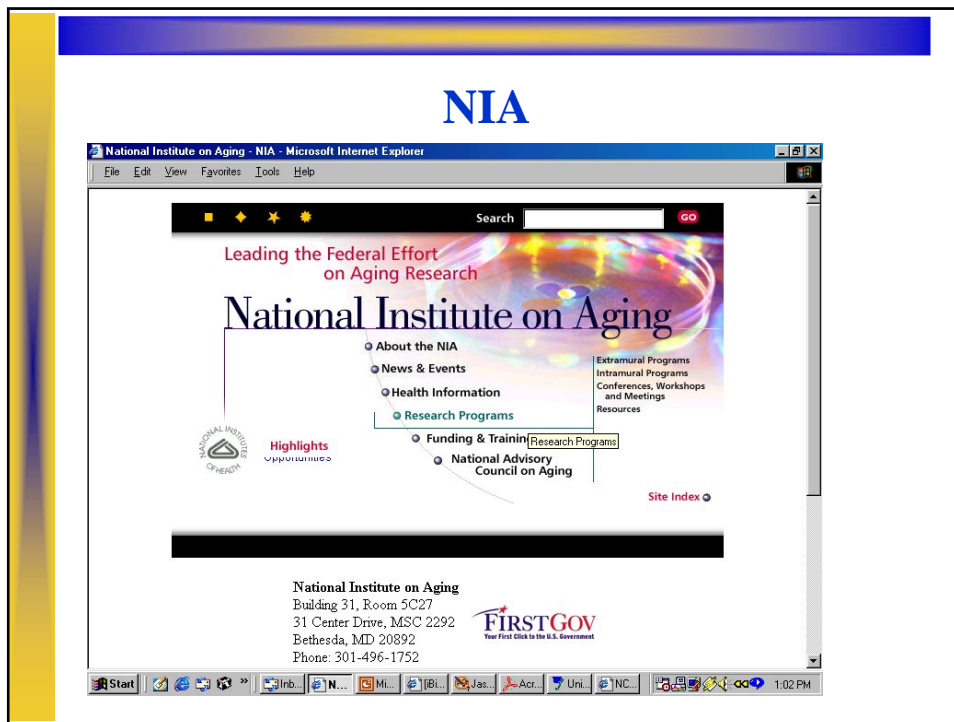

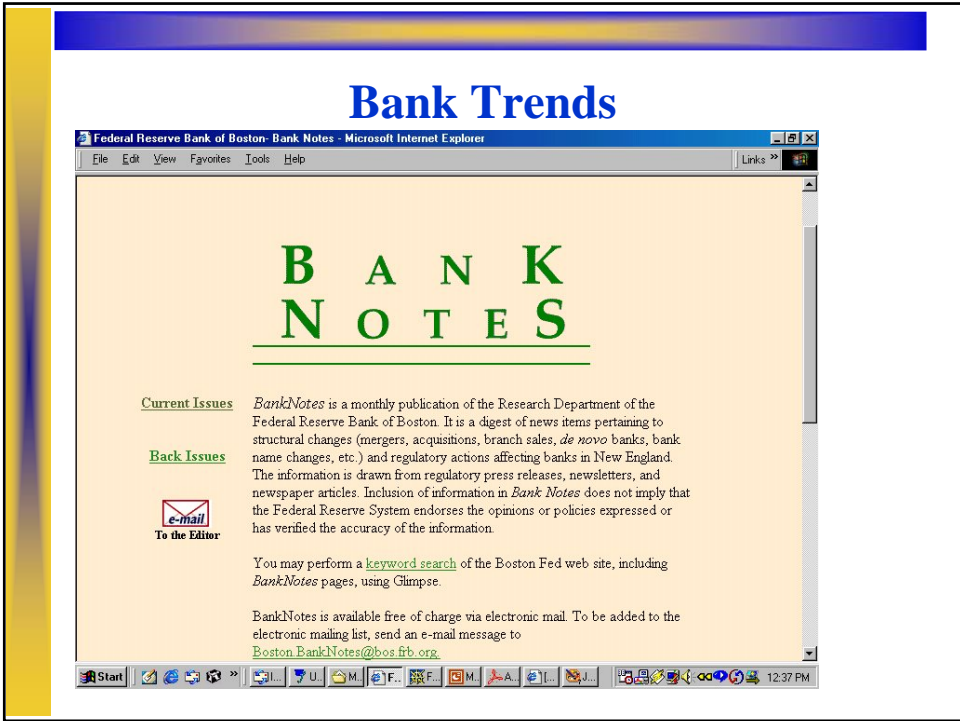
The Federal Reserve, the central bank of the United States, was founded by Congress in 1913 to provide the nation with a safer, more flexible, and more stable monetary and financial system.

Today the Federal Reserve's duties fall into four general areas: (1) conducting the nation's monetary policy; (2) supervising and regulating banking institutions and protecting the credit rights of consumers; (3) maintaining the stability of the financial system; and (4) providing certain financial services to the U.S. government, the public, financial institutions, and foreign official institutions.

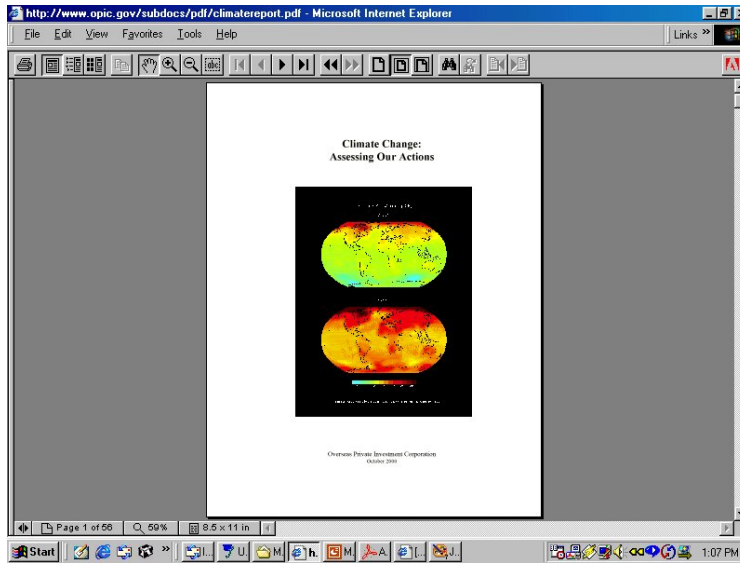

Vitamin B₆

As a consumer, you need information you can trust to help you make thoughtful decisions about eating a healthful diet and using vitamin and mineral supplements. Registered dietitians at the Warren Grant Magnuson Clinical Center, the clinical research hospital at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) in Bethesda, MD, developed this series of Fact Sheets in conjunction with the Office of Dietary Supplements in the Office of the Director of NIH to provide responsible information about the role of vitamins and minerals in health and disease and to help guide your decisions on the use of vitamin and mineral supplements. Each fact sheet in this series received extensive scientific review by recognized experts from the academic and research communities. The information is not intended to be a substitute for professional medical advice. It is important that you seek the advice of a physician, registered dietitian, pharmacist, or other qualified health care professional about the appropriateness of taking dietary supplements and their potential interactions with medications.

Vitamin B₆: What is it?
Vitamin B₆ is a water-soluble vitamin that exists in three major chemical forms: pyridoxine, pyridoxal, and pyridoxamine (1, 2). It performs a wide variety of functions in your body and is essential for your good health. For example, vitamin B₆ is needed for more than 100 enzymes involved in protein metabolism. It is also essential for red blood cell metabolism. The nervous
