

What FTC is doing: law enforcement

- ▶ The FTC & FDA sent warning letters to makers of teas, essential oils, and colloidal silver
 - ▶ Said their products would help prevent coronavirus
 - ▶ BUT: No evidence to back up claims

- ▶ Phishing emails & texts
 - ▶ Get your money
 - ▶ Get your information
 - ▶ Links to malware sites

Email/text scams & malicious websites

- ▶ Malicious websites
 - ▶ Lots of domains including “Coronavirus”
 - ▶ Stick with known, trusted sites
- ▶ Don’t click links from sources you don’t know

Robocalls

- ▶ Health-related calls
 - ▶ Cures! Prevention! Test kits! Telemedicine! Health insurance!
- ▶ Cleaning supplies
- ▶ Social Security Administration scams
- ▶ Mortgage relief scams
- ▶ Student loan debt relief scams
- ▶ More every day
- ▶ Report to [ftc.gov/complaint](https://www.ftc.gov/complaint)

Government stimulus checks

- ▶ The government **will not ask**
 - ▶ you to pay up front to get any money
 - ▶ for your SSN, bank account, or credit card number
- ▶ Anyone who tells you they can get you money NOW is a scammer.

Fake charities

- ▶ Often appear with crises
- ▶ Before you give: do your homework
- ▶ If you give, never pay by cash, gift card or money transfer.

Misinformation & rumors

Ask yourself these 3 questions:

- ▶ Who is this message from?
- ▶ What do they want me to do?
- ▶ What is the evidence behind this message?

5 things to know!

- ▶ Ignore offers of home tests
- ▶ Hang up
- ▶ Beware phishing and texts
- ▶ Donate with care

Here are **5 things** you can do to avoid a Coronavirus scam:

- **Ignore offers for vaccinations and home test kits.**
Scammers are selling products to treat or prevent COVID-19 without proof that they work.
- **Hang up on robocalls.**
Scammers use illegal sales call to get your money and your personal information.
- **Watch out for phishing emails and text messages.**
Don't click on links in emails or texts you didn't expect.
- **Research before you donate.**
Don't let anyone rush you into making a donation. Get tips on donating wisely at [ftc.gov/charity](https://www.ftc.gov/charity).
- **Stay in the know.**
