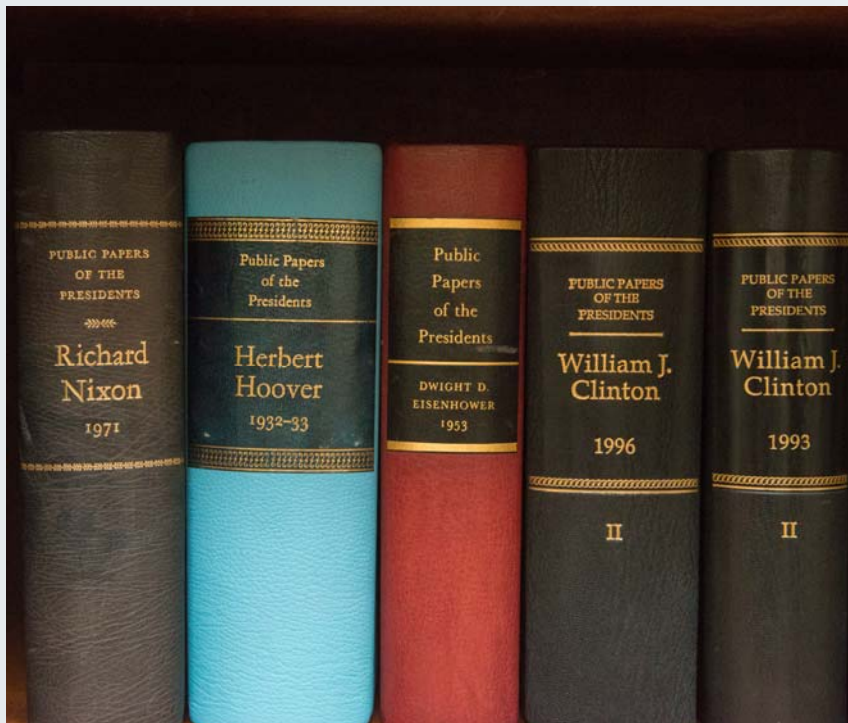

- Series began in 1957 as a National Historical Publications Commission recommendation
- 1 CFR 10 - Incorporated in regulations of the Administrative Committee of the Federal Register, issued under section 6 of the Federal Register Act (44 U.S.C. 1506)

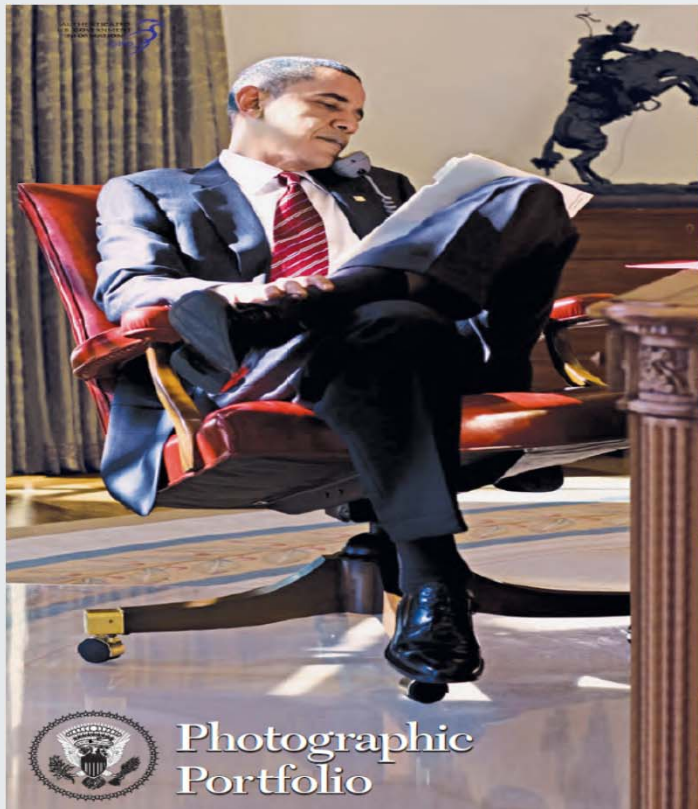
