



British ethnomusicologist John Blacking, in his widely read 1973 book, *How Musical Is Man?* (the answer is "very") proposed that we define music as "humanly organized sound," which, while useful, is perhaps too broad.



Music History from Primary Sources

The Art of Musical Notation

In its primary sources, music merges with the representational arts. Oral tradition has played a fundamental role in all ages, but in its formal sense, history--and the history of music--begins with the visual record.

Musical notation, having emerged on a wide scale in all civilizations, produced in itself a highly individual record of artistic endeavor. The medieval monks who compiled the missals and other liturgical books for the service of worship rose from their function as scribes to artists in their own right; among the greatest documents of Baroque art are the holographs by Bach; and an entirely novel phase in artistic musical score design was initiated in the twentieth century. The primary sources of music reproduced in this volume rely on various aspects of the graphic arts, but foremost among them stands the representation of the musical sound itself, the art of musical notation.

Among the manifold forms the written image of music has taken are letters or syllables, to represent individual tones, and symbols to represent groups of them. But a more advanced approach is expressed in notation guided not only by the wish to fix the immediate





The National Register Woodstock Music Festival site commemorates a three-day music festival that took place on August 15, 1969 - August 18, 1969, on nearly 300 acres of rolling farmland in rural Sullivan County, NY.

Listed on February 28, 2017, Woodstock is nationally significant, under Social History and Performing Arts/Music, as one of the most important cultural and social events of the second half of the twentieth century. The festival was the definitive expression of the musical, cultural, and political idealism of the 1960s and was recognized almost immediately as a watershed event in the transformation of American culture.

Meet Sesame Street's Global Cast of Characters

The American version of Sesame Street turns 40 years old this year, but Sesame Workshop currently co-produces local shows in 18 countries, each with their own, unique and culturally specific characters. Mexico's *Plaza Sésamo*, which currently airs in 34 countries, was one of the first co-productions the company undertook in 1972. Abelardo is a giant parrot and Big Bird' cousin. Just like his American counterpart, Abelardo is a full-body puppet, which means a person operates his movements from inside the costume, unlike the puppet-style muppets. Abelardo is the developmental age of a preschooler, slightly younger than his American cousin.

Kami Sesame Street (Sesame Workshop)

Issues that aren't as relevant to American audiences take center stage in some international versions. Kami, an asymptomatic, HIV-positive 5-year-old girl whose mother died of AIDS, made her debut on Takalani Sesame in September 2002. By creating her, Sesame Workshop hopes to encourage children to talk about HIV and AIDS and dispel misinformation such as the idea that using the same toilet as a person with HIV/AIDS is dangerous. On the show, Kami tells children to let someone know when they're feeling sick and that people need to help each other cheer up. Her name stems from kamogelo, a Setswana word that means "acceptance."
