About the Congressional Serial Set

The United States Congressional Serial Set collection was digitized by the Law Library of Congress, and is made publicly available through a partnership between the U.S. Government Publishing Office and the Law Library of Congress. The joint digitization project is a multi-year effort. Additional volumes of the Serial Set will be added to this collection as they are available.

The Serial Set is comprised of the numbered Senate and House Documents and Senate and House Reports, bound by Session of Congress. The contents of the Serial Set have varied throughout the publication's history, and at times have included House and Senate Journals, and the reports of executive departments and agencies.

Each volume is assigned a Serial Number, beginning with the 1st Session of the 15th Congress in 1817. Reports and Documents for each chamber begin with Number 1 at the beginning of the Congress, and are numbered consecutively through all sessions of that Congress. [Read More](#)

CoreTrustSeal Certification

- 16 criteria, Research Data Alliance
- Based on the ISO 16363 standard
- Over 160 repositories worldwide with CoreTrustSeal certification
 - Including 10 Federally-operated repositories (NASA, DOE, DOT, etc.)
- Peer review process
- Timing: begin after the TDR surveillance audit later in FY22





Looking Toward a Ficheless Future in Depository Libraries





Phase out of Microfiche


- Justification for microfiche phase out:
 - LSCM introduced the *Regional Depository Library Online Selection Policy* to allow regionals to deselect the tangible versions for authorized titles relying on the safety net of tangible in the four National Collection geographic regions.
 - More MF item numbers are being evaluated for phasing out.
 - Microfiche distributed through the FDLP is not preservation quality.
 - **YOU** have told us there is little to no demand for MF format.
 - Selection numbers for MF items are very low.
 - LSCM can no longer justify the production and distribution of FDLP microfiche.
 - Focus resources elsewhere on other FDLP initiatives.

There are over 1,100 designated Federal depository libraries (FDLs) located in 50 states, the District of Columbia, the Federated States of Micronesia and U.S. territories.


The U.S. Government Publishing Office (GPO) through the Federal Depository Library Program (FDLP) distributes Government information free of cost to these libraries, and the libraries provide free access for all users to this information. In addition, information specialists are available at these libraries to assist researchers with locating Federal information.

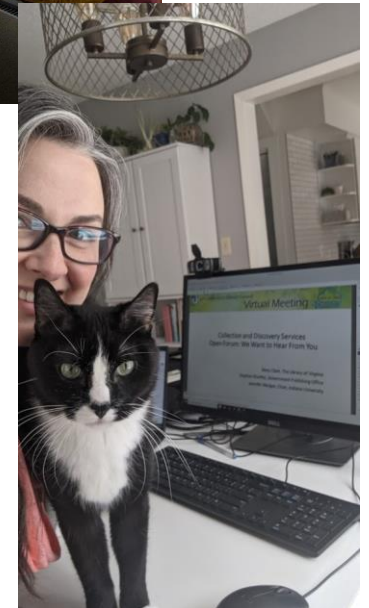
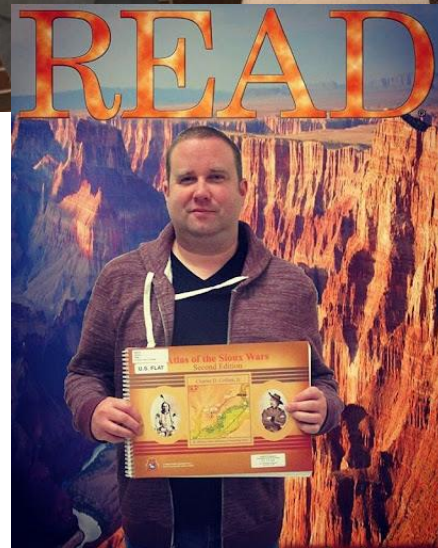

Government Publications Library at the University of Minnesota Twin Cities





Government Publications Library at the University of Minnesota Twin Cities

- Regional supporting 69 selectives in MN, SD, & MI.
- Strives to make Government information more discoverable and accessible.
- Collection housed across four libraries on campus, based on subject, to better connect researchers with materials they need.
- Supports long-term access and preservation, as well as broader access by collecting agency materials not distributed via the FDLP.
- Collection consists of nearly two million physical items, including maps, paper documents, microforms, and CD-ROMs, of which 95% is cataloged.
- First regional to catalog the bulk of the collection down to an item level.
- GPO partner.
- Early adopter of FDLP eXchange.
- Excellent promotion and educational outreach.
