

- CSTLTS awarded \$2.25 billion to 108 STLT agencies to address COVID-19-related health disparities and advance health equity through National Initiative to Address COVID-19 Health Disparities Among Populations at High-Risk and Underserved
- Serves as CDC's primary point of contact for tribal nations and convenes a tribal advisory committee
- Collaborates with 5 US territories and 3 freely associated states



- Connects tribal nations to CDC programs, funding, and resources


CSTLTS's Office of Island Affairs (OIA) works closely with the 5 US territories and 3 freely associated states
