Introduction

- 82% of FDLs make their collections findable through local catalog records in their integrated library system (ILS).
- Over half of FDLs also reported that they make their collections findable through their discovery services, finding aids/subject guides, and links on library web pages.
- 6% of FDLs also locally host a digital collection.
