



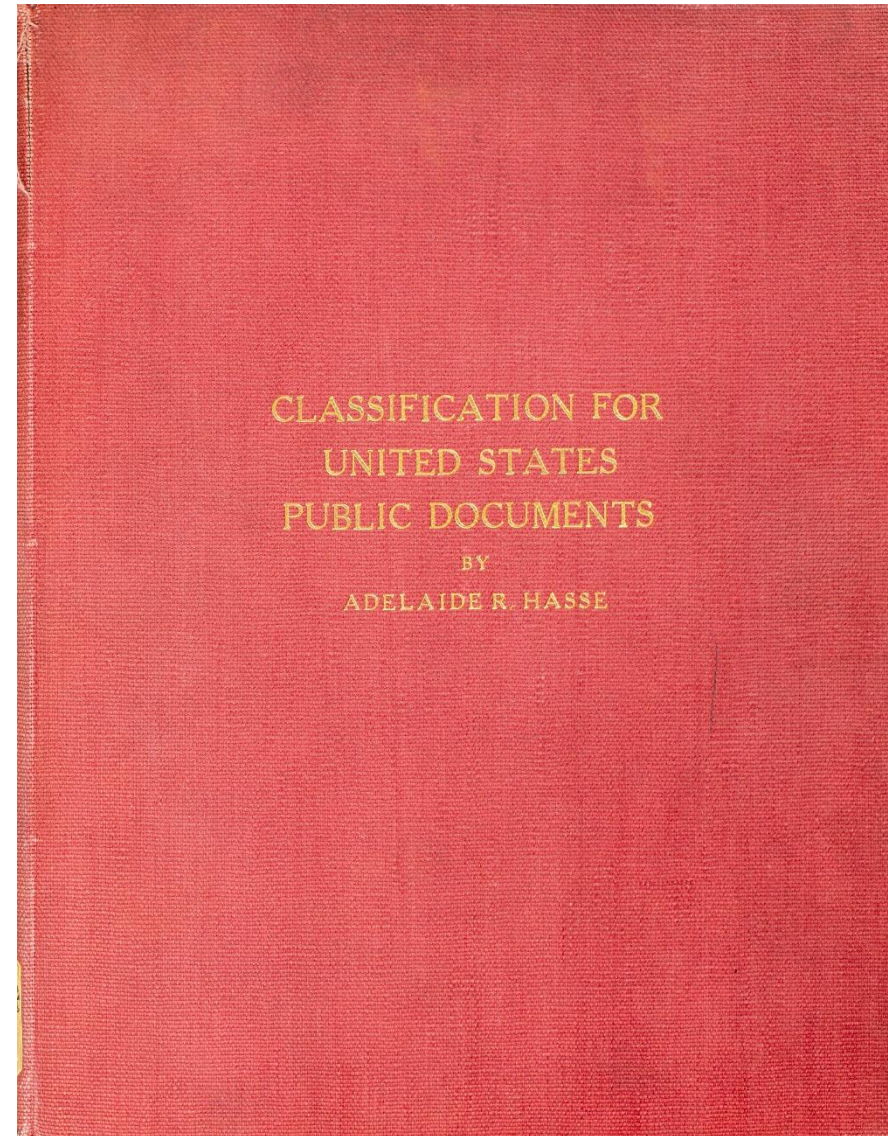

## XIII

Although under this scheme the Congressional series precedes the departmental publications, it seems desirable in this introduction to treat of the departmental publications first, because they form an overwhelmingly large proportion of the contents of the book.

### DEPARTMENTAL PUBLICATIONS

The classification of departmental publications is naturally the first matter to be taken into consideration. When the Office of the Superintendent of Documents was organized, no scheme in existence was found adequate for the classification of a large library composed exclusively of United States Government publications. A special scheme suited to our needs was later evolved, as explained in the preface to "Department list 1, List of publications of Agriculture Department, 1862-1902," which was issued by the Superintendent of Documents in 1904. This classification, used with such success for the publications of the Department of Agriculture, has been applied to the publications of all Executive Departments and independent publishing offices, as shown in the present Checklist. The following explanation of the classification will, it is hoped, make the principles so clear that any library which desires to adopt this special scheme may experience no difficulties in its application.

The classification of departmental publications is by Government authors: first, by Departments or independent publishing offices; second, by bureaus, offices, or divisions of such Departments or independent publishing offices; third, by series; fourth, by book numbers.

#### *Department symbol, first term in classification number*

The first letter of the distinctive word in the name of each of the nine Executive Departments is used to designate the Department.

- A = Agriculture Department.
- C = Commerce and Labor Department.
- I = Interior Department.
- J = Justice Department.
- N = Navy Department. ✓
- P = Post-Office Department. D = De f... ✓
- S = State Department.
- T = Treasury Department.
- W = War Department. ✓

Two letters are used for independent publishing offices.

- AR = American Republics Bureau. [Since Aug. 1910, called Pan American Union.]
- CS = Civil Service Commission.
- DC = District of Columbia.

TO LIBRARIANS

Beginning with the Monthly catalogue for July, 1924, the number given at the extreme right of each entry (except for Congressional documents and reports) is the classification number by which the publication is arranged in the Library and in the Sales Stock of the Office of the Superintendent of Documents. It can be used as a classification number by such libraries as are using, for the Departmental publications, the arrangement of public documents advocated in the Check list of United States public documents, 1789-1909. In using this number as a classification number in a library, it should be noted that the shilling mark (/) is used to separate what would ordinarily be a superior number or letter (the numbers or letters immediately following the line) from the main classification number, it not being practicable to print these numbers and letters as superiors in the Monthly catalogue, e. g., the number A 1.23/a : So96/4 listed in the Monthly catalogue would be A 1.23<sup>a</sup> : So96<sup>4</sup> in a library.

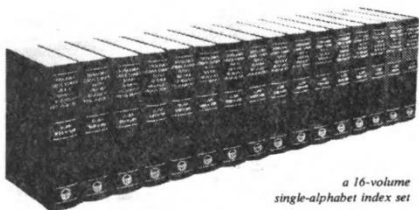

Now, for the first time, librarians with documents collections of every size and type will be able to identify the Superintendent of Documents Classification Numbers for more than one million titles published by the U.S. Government over the past 187 years and, also for the first time, be able to use these Su Docs Class Numbers to order facsimile or microfilm copies of specific documents from a centralized source (the Public Archives Branch of the National Archives and Records Service).

The massive Cumulative Title Index can be used either by itself to order documents when the title, date, and Su Docs Numbers are sufficient identification; or in conjunction with *Checklist '76*, when it is desirable to learn complete bibliographic data on a publication prior to ordering copies (e.g., to find out the numbers of pages which will have to be copied @ 15¢ a piece, or to isolate specific numbers or parts of series).

In addition to the title, Su Docs Class Number, and the date of the information in the document, each entry also indicates with an "I" or an "A" whether the microfilm image of the complete card can be found (in Su Docs Classification-sequence) in the "Active" section (Reels 1-56) or in the "Inactive" section (Reels 57-118). Lists of the specific contents of all the microfilm reels are contained in the endpapers of each index volume.

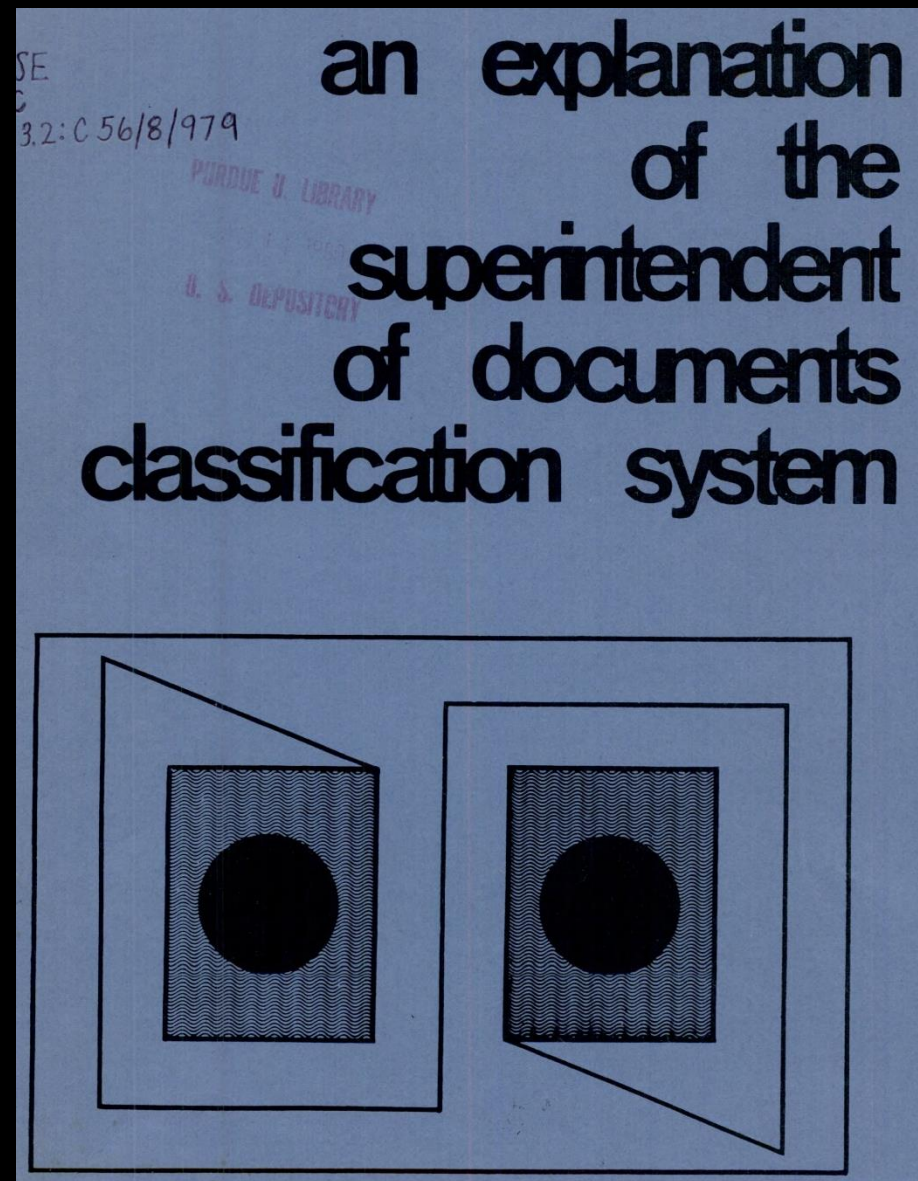

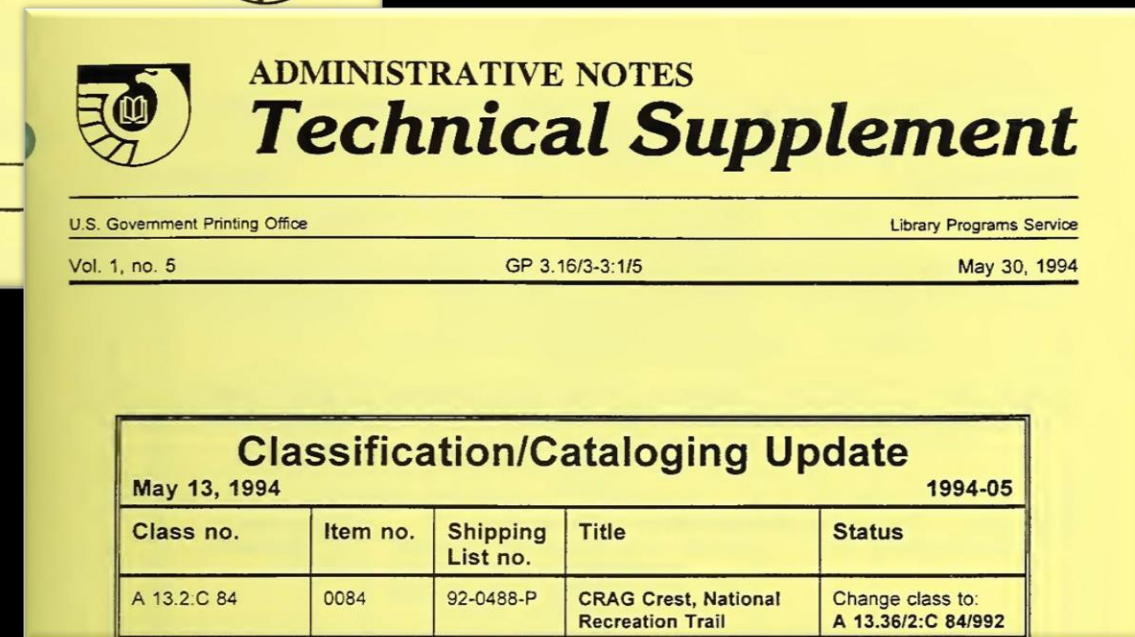
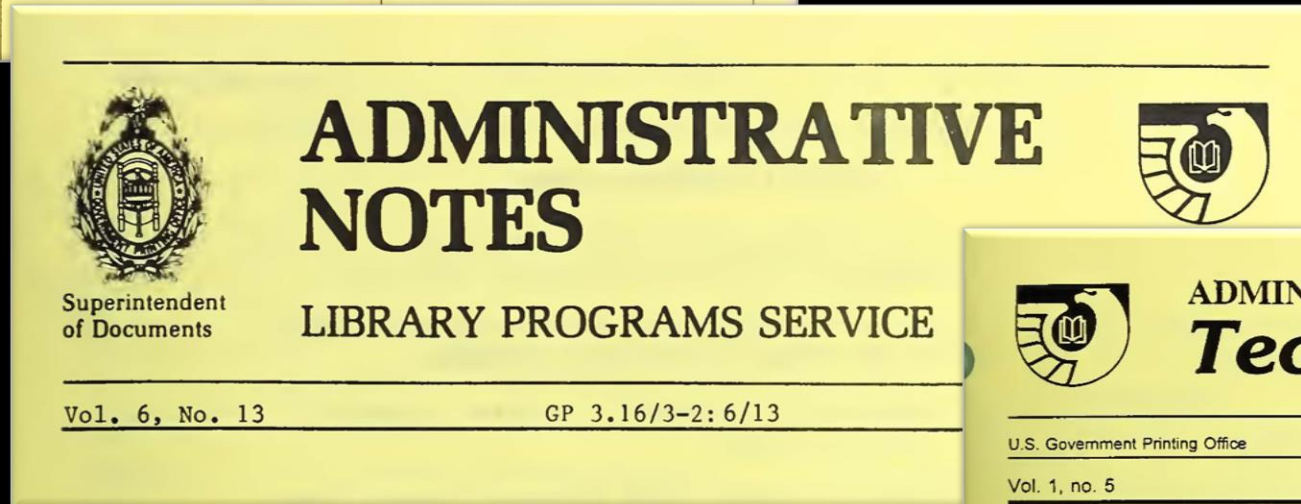
