
# **Organizational History**

1974 U.S. Fire Prevention and Control Administration created within Department of Commerce

Administration

1978 Name changed to U.S. Fire Administration (USFA) 1979 USFA placed within newly created Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) 2002 FEMA (and USFA) placed within newly created Department of Homeland Security










*America Burning* is the 1973 report that described the scope of the nation's fire problem and raised awareness of the critical need for fire prevention. The report recommended the creation of the USFA

Contains a maze that children can navigate to get an ambulance to their home. The activity sheet folds into an ambulance. Recommended ages: 3-7.






Cards are available on a wide variety of topics.

## National Emergency Training Center Library Index and Catalog


Our database is more than a local catalog!


In addition to our books, we also index:

# National Emergency Training Center Library Indexing Program

The library currently indexes approximately 75 periodicals with active subscriptions, both trade and scholarly.

Most of our indexing is **selective**.

Generally excluded:

- Short articles (less than 2 pages)
- News articles with short horizons
- Articles not relevant to fire service, EMS or emergency management


Fiscalyear 2023 stats: 2,200 articles indexed
