- GitHub is a web-based computer source code sharing and publishing service.
- Repositories are the highest-level component of GitHub sites.
- You do not need a GitHub account to view or download resources from repositories.
- We offer several types of resources.
- You can use our repositories and resources in multiple ways.



### Why We Use GitHub

- Provide free downloading of the MARC records in the Catalog of U.S. Government Publications (CGP)
- Create customized record sets, which are groups of records based on various criteria
- Offer new products and services to Federal depository libraries, the general library community, and the public
- Represent the critical work of our staff members.

#### **General Information**

Library Services & Content Management (LSCM) of the <u>United States Government Publishing Office (GPO)</u> created this repository to offer files of MARC bibliographic records of the <u>Catalog of U.S. Government Publications (CGP)</u> for downloading free of charge. Library Technical Services (LTS), a department of LSCM, manages the resources in this repository. The CGP is the GPO's finding tool for publications of the executive, judicial, and legislative branches, and other entities of the U.S. Federal Government. The CGP records comprise the National Bibliography of U.S. Government Publications and contain descriptive and subject information to enable the discovery of these resources. Many CGP records provide PURL (persistent uniform resource locator) links to the online versions of publications. For more information, please visit the <u>CGP help pages</u>. These files can be used for catalog and collection maintenance purposes.

#### **CGP Records Monthly Files**


This collection contains the monthly files of new and changed Catalog of U.S. Government Publications (CGP) records posted during the year between each annual set of all CGP records. The records are available in three types of files:

- · New and changed records in combined files
- · New records only
- Changed records only

The records are available in UTF-8, MARC-8, and MARCXML formats. The naming conventions of the files are as follows: cataloging\_records-YYYYMM\_####\_format.mrc . The abbreviation YYYYMM stands for the year and month, and #### represents the number of bibliographic records in the record set. Format indicates if the character set is in UTF-8, MARC-8, or MARC XML format.




## U.S. Congressional Serial Set Project Repository


#### Reference Services

#### Technical Services


- Download the MARC files to add to your catalogs.
