Historic Monthly Catalog

- In January 2024, ProQuest (PQ) announced the retirement of their Monthly Catalog of United States Government Publications (MoCat) Database.
- In April 2024, Superintendent of Documents (SuDoc), Scott Matheson, established an agreement with PQ to share their xml data and make it publicly searchable in a database format.
- Since then, GPO has acquired the ProQuest data and assessed options to achieve the SuDoc's goal.
- GPO is currently conducting a Proof of Concept (PoC) to validate an approach to extract MoCat entries from the PQ xml data in MARC format for searching within the Catalog of Government Publications (CGP) platform as a separate and distinct database from the CGP.
 - Data extraction resulted in over 1.2M individual MoCat entries.
- With a successful PoC, GPO anticipates making the Historic MoCat database available later this fiscal year.

This is derived from the requirements for cataloging and indexing codified at 44 U.S.C. §§1710-1711 and 44 U.S.C. §4101(a).






Digital Content Acquisitions Workflow

Priorities for website level collection:

- Must be within scope of FDLP and C&I Program
- Little to no distribution through print
- Disseminated through web and not in our catalog
- Avoid too much duplication of effort with other agencies
- Work with the Collection Development Librarian to help determine the need
- Notification/nomination from the community

Archived Page of the National Credit Union Administration by archived dates







PURLs-- Links to the Digital Content

- PURL stands for Persistent Uniform Resource Locator
- A PURL is a URL that points to a specific resource (like an article, book, or web page) on the web.
- When a resource's URL changes, a PURL can be updated to point to the new location, ensuring that the link remains valid.



Congressionally Mandated Reports Collection Growth






